

#### A REFLECTION BY FR. WILLIAM HERIC

Dear Friends in Christ,

The church returns to "Ordinary Time" with two solemnities that can only be described as "Extraordinary." This week we celebrate **Trinity Sunday**, our central belief in the one God who reveals the divine life in three persons. We enter the life of this divine community of love when we are baptized



in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. We invoke the trinity every time we make the sign of the cross, a sacramental moment whenever we do it, like at the beginning and end of every Mass.

Next Sunday, June 11, we celebrate the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**, our belief in the real presence of Christ given us in consecrated bread and wine. The precious blood of Christ has generally not been shared these past two years because of the Covid pandemic. It's time for that to change. **Beginning June 10-11, you will have the option of receiving holy communion from the cup.** Please feel welcome to do so if you wish, or to decline to receive in this form if you prefer not. Parents of children who have recently received their first holy communion please consider what practice you want to encourage for your family.

Ordinary time begins our transition into "Summer mode," with its break from school, vacations, and more time outdoors. A gentle word of encouragement to keep Sunday Mass a regular part of your summertime. Please consult our parish communications for various opportunities to celebrate our faith, hope, and love this summer. An important one coming up is our "Synod Listening Sessions" on June 11 and 12. The Partners in the Gospel planning process will be a special focus of these sessions. Hope to see you at one of these gatherings!

#### **NEWS FROM SVDP**

Below is a section from the St. Vincent de Paul Rule that explains a bit about the objectives of our volunteer ministry to our neighbors.

Vincentians are called to journey together towards holiness, because true holiness is perfect union with Christ and the perfection of love, which



is central to their vocation and the source of its fruitfulness. They aspire to burn with the love of God as revealed by Christ and deepen their own faith and fidelity. Vincentians are aware of their own brokenness and need for God's grace. They seek His glory, not their own. Their ideal is to help relieve suffering for love alone, without thinking of any award or advantage for themselves.

They draw nearer to Christ, serving Him in the poor and one another. They grow more perfect in love by expressing compassionate and tender love to the poor and one another.

The Catholic church teaches us that we are all called to holiness, wherever we may be. We all walk different paths toward the perfection that Christ calls each of us to embody, using the various gifts and talents we have been given. For members of St. Vincent de Paul, the vocation to support our neighbors is our special way of being Catholic, living out what it means to be an everyday "saint next door". We were created to live in community and see our SVdP conference as a genuine community of faith and love, of prayer and action. (Rule, Part 1, 3.3) We grow in holiness by sharing the volunteer work we do and reflecting on God's presence in all of it – one person, one neighbor, one community at a time.




#### **ACA GIVING UPDATE**
