

Solidarity

The bulletin insert, Solidarity, is part of the U.S. Catholic Bishops' "Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship," emphasizes principle as a cornerstone of the Church's social teaching. Solidarity goes beyond occasional acts of charity, calling for a deep commitment to the common good and the well-being of all people, regardless of their background. As members of one global human family, Catholics are urged to act in ways that reflect our interconnectedness.

This principle demands that we prioritize the needs of the vulnerable and marginalized in our political and social actions. involves Solidarity addressing systemic issues like poverty. inequality, immigration, racism; advocating for policies that protect human dignity, and fostering a culture of life that supports families, the poor, and those impacted by climate change and war/conflicts.

Pope Francis, in **Fratelli Tutti**, underscores that true solidarity requires action that promotes justice and peace, both locally and globally. Catholics are called to imitate the Good Samaritan, engaging in "radical solidarity" by supporting those in need and working to build a society rooted in compassion and justice. Through prayer and political engagement, the faithful can contribute to creating a world that reflects God's love for all.
