OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY!

On Wednesday, October 5, the students will be praying the Rosary as a school in Church at 2 PM. Parents and family are certainly welcome. READING AND MATH DIAGNOSTIC RESULTS + RUNNING RECORDS = DIFFERENTIATION

All students in grades 2-8 have completed reading and math diagnostic tests. Results will be sent home to parents today. Teachers are also conducting running records of students in K5-5th grade to learn more about their students' strengths and areas for growth in reading. For running records, teachers listen to individual students read a short fiction story and nonfiction passage and record their accuracy in saying the words. They also ask the students questions about what they read to determine their comprehension, or understanding of the text.

Our staff is going to use the test results to help us better differentiate for our students. One of our building goals this year is to use students' individual reading data to better meet their needs in all subjects. Feel free to reach out to teachers if you have questions.
