

# Who is My Best Friend?

One day last week my 5-year-old grandson was sitting at the lunch table across from his grandfather. At some point in their conversation, he looked up and asked his grandpa to try to "guess who my best friend is." Many names were guessed; none of them, however, solved the riddle correctly. Grandfather finally "conceded defeat" and asked his grandson to tell him the name that would correctly answer the question. My grandson looked up and with a beaming grin said, "Jesus! – God sent Him down and He died for us." Upon hearing what my grandson's response had been, I felt myself utterly amazed. In my mind, the phrase resounded, "from the mouths of babes..."

What my young grandson has already come to know is a truth that applies not just to the very young, but to all of us, regardless of age: Jesus reaches out to all people to be His friend. Every week we have the opportunity to celebrate the Mass and share the Eucharist as a way to strengthen our friendship with Jesus. On their First Holy Communion Day, the second graders will share in the Eucharist and will be able to experience firsthand Jesus' all-encompassing friendship that He wishes to share with each of us through this sacrament.

My wish for these young people is that they have the opportunity to foster this friendship with Jesus through their lives. The Eucharist (the Mass) can be a life-transforming experience for us all.

# **God and Social Media**

I have both Facebook and Twitter accounts that I use occasionally. They are intriguing and a little addictive. You read one post that leads you to viewing pictures and then reading one witty saying after another witty saying. You can look at businesses that use them as well. One might see an interesting Tweet that leads you to an article. This can lead to another tweet and another link. You can choose to follow or not follow. If you don't understand what I'm writing, don't feel badly as I barely know what I'm talking about. When one does engage in social media, it can take a tremendous amount of time. Some of that time could have been spent in prayer or service. For this reason, I use caution when using social media. Reading social media has caused more than one night prayer time to be delayed for me.

On the other hand, especially for the younger generation, social media is here to stay. If I control who I follow, there is a way to be sure your Twitter feed is full of things you like. I mostly follow Catholic people like the Pope, a few Cardinals, bishops, and other prominent Catholic people so I can learn something and be inspired by people of faith, and so social media can give me avenues to learn, share, and evangelize.

There is generally good and bad in most things and social media is no different. Social Media may make it easier to gain knowledge. Sometimes it helps us to keep track of friends and relatives we don't see very often. We are free to use this type of communication or not. When used rightly, there is great potential in how these forms of media can be used. I see them used as tools for evangelization. You never know what or who God will put in our lives to help build the Kingdom of Heaven right here on earth.


