

Reflection on the issues of today...

Who is our family?

This was the reflection used for the Word and Communion service on July 19, in reference to the gospel, Mt 12:46-50.

Did Jesus really have brothers? Our Catholic Church tells us that Mary remained a virgin. Some Christian faiths accept the fact that Jesus may have had biological siblings. Today, I think the far more important question in our gospel is, "Who is our family?"

Our world, and right now our country, is going through a very scary time. But we can just sit back and watch the news on TV......that's not my mother, or brother, or sister that's closing down the freeways in the Twin Cities. Those people are different. Didn't they get themselves into these messy situations?

I like to tell myself that I am not a prejudiced person. I have no reason to dislike black people ... as long as they're in the Twin Cities. I have no reason to dislike the Hispanic people.....as long as they stay living in Montgomery. I perk up my ears when the news tells of a car accident that killed children.....and then hear that it was a Somali family that probably didn't know how to drive very well. Oh well, doesn't affect me. I perk up my ears when I hear that a young child had been shot......oh, no big deal, it was North Minneapolis again.

Shame on me. Maybe I am prejudiced. Don't those families feel the same pain that I would in a given situation? Do they love any less, even though their circumstances are different than ours?

In the gospel today, Jesus challenges us, as his disciples, to reconsider the categories and criteria we use to divide "us" from "them", "insiders" from "outsiders," our "brothers and sisters" from "the crowd." Jesus isn't calling those who follow him to love their families any less, he is calling us to love others more, to consider those outside of family our brothers and sisters.

Recently Father Kevin asked for volunteers to be on a committee to help process how we might better respond to what is happening in our country. He alluded to the fact that we have to start truly listening to one another. Just recently there was a request on our prayer chain to pray for a family whose teenager was out of control. Not having any idea who that might be, my heart still went out to that family. Would I have felt the same if I had known the request came from North Minneapolis, or from a mother wearing a burka?

It is very hard to change laws......but is it possible to change hearts? How do we walk in the moccasins......or the sandals...... or even the Nike tennis shoes.....of another? Can we really try to know what is in the heart of those who feel so wronged? Maybe our smallest comment to friends or family members can build bridges.....instead of walls.

How can we change our thinking about "us" and "them," and instead ask, "Who is my brother, or sister, or family member?

An Olympic Thought

I've been following the Olympics most of my life. This summer I even got to tour the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs. I find the stories inspirational. One of the events I'm totally in awe of is the decathlon. They often refer to the winner as the greatest athlete in the world. This might not be true, but they sure are talented to be good at so many events. I ran one year of Junior College track, but the decathlon seemed out of reach for me even in my prime.

I believe that being a good Catholic is like being a decathlete. Unlike the physical athletes, everyone can be part of the church. Far from the pray, pay, and obey Catholics of times past, modernday Catholics are asked to do so much more. First of all, we are called to have full active participation in the Mass. Missing Mass can be a serious sin. Sure there are circumstances like illness, weather, and traveling to a remote location; but for the most part, we are all called to be in the pew. With the variety of Mass times in the area, it should be a rare circumstance that we are not part of the regular worshiping community. We shouldn't simply watch Mass; no, it is a participation sport. All of us need to, at a minimum, respond in prayer and to follow the music. Help out with a liturgical ministry, like being a lector or server or even bringing up the gifts. We should all take a turn and I'm eternally grateful to all who have participated in the past. You are champions in your own right.

We can also be involved in leadership, education, fundraising, maintenance, outreach, or other valuable activities that make our churches great. Being involved is not just for the select few. We invite everyone. At different stages in life, we sometimes are able to help more; but everyone needs to make an effort, as this church belongs to everyone. Sure there is the role of the clergy or church staff person, but their work would be impossible without the people of God, who are the real decathletes of our faith.




