

St. Wenceslaus School News

The school year is up and running for another great year. We are excited to have many new families and students who have chosen our faith-filled environment. Our school is committed to teaching our students to develop a relationship with God in our daily interactions, through prayer, and through study. We develop the heart and souls of our students along with providing an outstanding academic education. St. Wenceslaus School has now become a C-STEM focused school. C-STEM stands for our Catholic school with a focus on science, technology, engineering, and math. The day consists of a one-hour walk followed by prizes and a hot dog lunch provided by the local Knights of Columbus. It is a festive event that brings all school families together with school spirit that can't be beat! Students are now going door-todoor collecting pledges. From the Desk of Father Dave

Divine Healer

I had a busy Thursday ahead of me. I was going to have the funeral service for Taylor Wieland that day. I had a busy weekend ahead of me. I had a marriage couple to meet with. I was going to meet with a young man entering the Catholic Church. I was going to lead a Patriotic Rosary. I, I, I...but God had other plans. On the brink of exhaustion and not having a decent meal since Monday, I went to the ER of the Mayo Hospital in New Prague on Wednesday evening. The doctors poked and prodded me through a series of tests determining I had pneumonia. Being quite sick, Fr. Kevin anointed me and my journey of healing began.

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is a vital ministry in our Church. However, it was far from the only one I experienced during my three days in the hospital. The staff gave excellent care including doctors to nurses, those that made my wonderful meals, kept my room clean and all who helped to heal me as I journey to recovery. I will be forever grateful. Each of them ministered in their own way. Most of the decisions made were right on, and even though I had a few setbacks, there was always a reason for hope.

The reason for hope is your prayers to the Divine Healer of which I am so appreciative. My illness was rather minor compared to the travails you may have faced, but the Divine Healer is there for all of us. The Paschal mystery becomes very real when we are sick. We can connect our pain and suffering to what Jesus experienced on the cross. There may be death or loss, and Jesus knows how hard this is for us. Then of course there is the resurrection. We become healed, we make progress, or sometimes it gets worse resulting in death. The Divine Healer is always there to come to our assistance no matter who we are or in what condition we are in.


