

From the Desk of Father Dave

White as Snow

I'm not a big fan of snow these days, as I do a considerable amount of driving. I do remember a time when I loved snow. Sledding, cross country skiing, and even snowball fights dominated my youth. I still like the way new fallen snow looks on the trees, lawns, and rooftops. White makes things look clean and new. Even though we have to plow and shovel it, there is a certain beauty to at least small amounts of snow.

Reconciliation can be like snow. It makes us clean and new. We might have a fear of reconciliation as we would with a large amount of snow. Yet we know our land and lakes rely on snow for moisture that brings renewal in the spring to come. The soul is renewed by reconciliation. When we confess our sins and make ourselves right with God, there is a feeling of relief. The priest acts in the person of Christ to take in the sin and grant forgiveness. There is no sin too grave that God's mercy can't forgive. Don't think you have any sins? We all have some. If we look hard enough, we can find things we want to let go of. When our burdens are lifted, we can enter the excitement of Christmas with a new sense of peace.

Even though Christmas is close, there are still a few chances to go. Today (December 18th) there is a 4 pm service in Jordan. There will be a prayer service followed by individual confession by area priests. There is generally about 5-7 priests there to choose from. There will be a similar service in Montgomery at 6 pm. Individual confessions will also occur both Monday and Tuesday nights. On Monday, I will be at St. John in the confessional from 6:30 to 7:30. I will stay until I'm finished. On Tuesday, I will be at St. Scholastica with the same times. Jesus is waiting for you to come forward and be made new.

Excerpts from Fr. Kevin's Homily of December 11, 2016:

Our faith community is one of the signs the Messiah is present in the here and now of the New Prague area.

We are a very active parish. I can't begin to know it all or completely keep all the activity straight. There is tremendous variety and diverse activity. We have much to be proud of.

1. We have a wonderful new parking lot.

- 2. We have 8 of our school faculty that graduate this year with coat and gown as certified STEM trained teachers.
- 3. Hope House with volunteer food, staff, and other support bridges families without a roof over their heads, into a situation where they are able to sustain a place for their families.
- 4. Excellent music supports our communal worship. We involve many of our parish in all different ages in our musical prayer.
- 5. We have book clubs and other gatherings for women--young and older.

6. Young Catholic families host events.


- 7. Our liturgical routines involve 6 Masses at 6 different times and at 3 different places that help people worship together while maintaining busy schedules.
- 8. This past year we served 50 grieving families with a funeral service or Mass.

9. 200 students are educated in our elementary school.

- 10. 350 students participate with religious education from pre-school to the whole of high school.
- 11. Grief, post-suicide, divorce/separated support groups regularly gather.

So I would ask everyone, as you plan for your charitable contributions during the tax year of 2016, that you remember your spiritual household. Collections are well below the challenge we give in the bulletin each week. But more importantly the collection income is \$19,000 below what we budgeted to collect so far this year. I believe that the ministries of our parish that you support are evidence that the Messiah is present. 
