
2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

ORDINARY TIME IS AN EXTRAORDINARY TIME

Often we think of ordinary as being mundane and boring. Quite to the contrary, ordinary can be extraordinary. Yes, it is true that the Seasons of Advent and Christmas are quite extraordinary times. Yet, all the glitter and glitz of Advent and Christmas does not extraordinary make. What makes the ordinary extraordinary is in how we think and approach it.

The liturgical year, like the calendar year is a cycle of months and seasons that chronologically flow from one to another. This cycle can be thought of as a bit of a rut, a "here we go again, the same old, same old." Or, we can think of it as a new adventure upon which we embark.

Think of how we were last January. Over the past year, our lives have not remained static. Our bodies have changed for better or for worse. Hopefully, during this time, our wisdom, our knowledge, and our experience have grown. In one way or another, we are physically, mentally, and emotionally different today than we were one year ago. Have we grown spiritually during this past year?

Over the next few Sundays, we will hear the familiar stories of Jesus beginning his earthly mission of spreading the Good News of God's love. We will hear him calling his disciples and all people to a deeper relationship with God, his Father. Throughout Ordinary Time, we will hear familiar stories of healing miracles, the nature miracles, and extraordinary feats like the feeding of the 5,000. These stories should speak to us in a different way this year, especially if our relationship with God has grown.

The calendar year and the liturgical year are not circular ruts through which we pass again and again. Rather, every new year is spherical, always changing, always new. Human relationships that are static and never change die. Can that be said of our relationship with God? This new year, as ordinary as it might seem, is filled with extraordinary surprises. God is always calling us into a deeper relationship. Our relationship with God is always extraordinary, no matter the time or season of the year. We have a choice to make this new year. Will our relationship with God remain static and dead or will we choose to deepen and enliven our relationship with God? Will we make this Ordinary Time extraordinary or just ordinary?

What to Do When We Are Cold

This season has already had some serious cold. That -27 stuff was horrible; even these nagging single digits below zero can get annoying. I do say I prefer it to snow. You don't have to shovel cold, and if you have a decent car that starts in the cold, it is better for driving. The air is fresh and many times it is sunny. Most people think there is nothing we can do about the cold and they find themselves in a bit of a rut.

I believe this is an awesome time to hunker down and be on fire for Christ. Jesus will warm you up if you are willing to be open to his marvelous love. Take some of this extra indoor time as time to pray. Couch potatoes with TV addiction can pull ourselves away to pray. Ignite that fire with a good conversation with Jesus. Perhaps a devotion can help that flame spread. I suggest reading the readings for the week with loved ones and letting scripture burn into our hearts. On January 15th (today for many of you), our youth are experiencing a lively retreat with the National Evangelization Team. NET is a group of young people from 18-28 who travel throughout our country for 9 months using song, skits, and small group time to help evangelize youth. Please take a moment out of your day to pray for them.

The wisdom of our local church is that our individual churches are stronger together. I know in the beginning our small churches were asked to work together and that there would be some separation from St. Wenceslaus. We have lived this way for a number of years. We are now working toward more cooperation. All change takes time and is often done in stages. In the Western Catholic Community, we will still have our small communities of worship and we will also focus more on our greater rural presence. Know that leadership is here to listen and to make a human connection so the flame of the Holy Spirit is kept burning brightly.




