Discipleship is an ongoing
journey of conversion.

Stage 3: Openness

People at this stage have a tentative openness to God and the possibility of spiritual change. They are beginning to see how God is acting in their lives, but are not yet able to make a commitment to a relationship with God. They may have many questions about the Church but have not actively searched out answers.

How we can help people at this stage:

- Answer their questions
- Share personal faith stories
- Form authentic friendships
- Create safe spaces to talk freely

Here are 5 stages of conversion:*

Trust – Curiosity – Openness – Seeking – Intentional discipleship

*There are different models for this process of conversion. This one comes from the book *Forming Intentional Disciples* by Sherry Weddell.

From the Desk of Father Dave

A Declaration

When we think of Valentine's Day, there are good thoughts about love and marriage. Often vows are renewed, gifts are given, and some people go on retreats about marriage. I love to help prepare couples for marriage. We like to envision happiness, cooperation, and spiritual unity. With hard work, this can be achieved by the grace of God. No one is perfect, a marriage has to be lived every day as a real give and take proposition. Both the good and the bad can help promote growth. In order for things to work out, a couple must declare their love for each other in many and varied ways.

Sometimes the bond that is supposed to hold a marriage together doesn't form. The two people have some serious problem and it can result in a civil divorce. At the time of divorce, an individual is welcome to take comfort in the church. There are groups for separated and divorced people. Those in need can take advantage of the sacraments. It is only when people get married again outside the church that the church is saddened. One should not receive communion or hold positions of leadership within the church. This can be a very hard time for individuals and clergy and lay ministers must offer their love and care to these individuals.

When someone has been civilly divorced, they can seek a declaration of nullity commonly called an annulment. All marriages are seen as sacred in the eyes of the church. The Tribunal that handles these cases works hard to make a decision on an annulment that honors each individual. Often the experts can see from the evidence gathered that a bond between the two parties did not form. Children in an annulled marriage are not illegitimate; they are recognized as children of God no matter what the parents do. Pope Francis has recently offered changes to marriage tribunals so that cases are resolved in timely and pastoral ways. If you are in need of an annulment, contact Fr. Kevin, me, or someone at the Archdiocesan Tribunal directly. May God bless anyone who goes through this process.

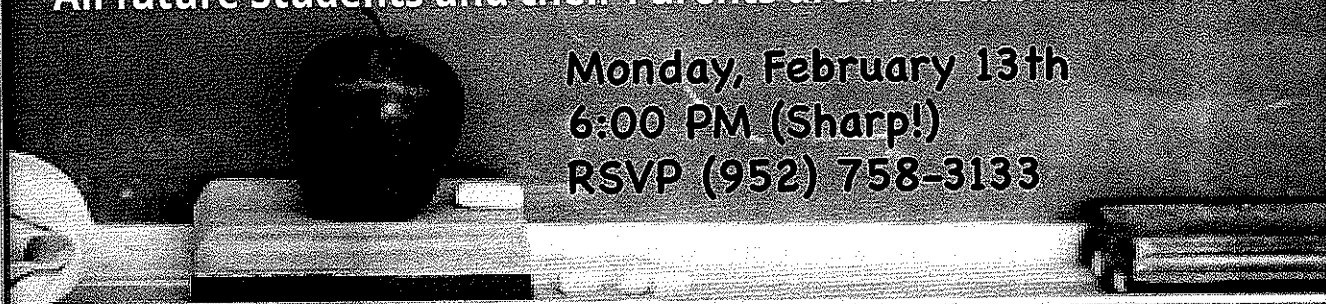

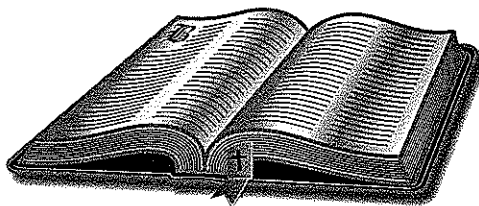

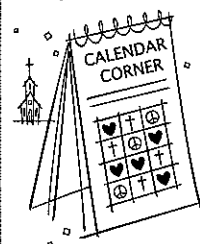
