
7TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Discipleship is an ongoing journey of conversion.

Stage 4: Seeking

The seeker is intentionally exploring a relationship with Jesus and his Church, feeling a need to make a decision and commitment. This may involve a series of smaller commitments.

How we can help people at this stage:

- Create safe spaces to talk freely and answer their questions
- Pray for and with them
- Connect them with scripture

Stage 5: Intentional Discipleship

Discipleship is making a choice to turn one's life over to Jesus. Intentional disciples give of themselves, study to grow deeper in their faith, and discern what God might be asking of them.

How we can help people at this stage:

- Provide a rich parish environment with a variety of opportunities for further growth.
- Engage them in the work and life of the parish, in service to others, sharing their faith, and prayer.

Here are 5 stages of conversion:*

Trust - Curiosity - Openness - Seeking - Intentional discipleship

*There are different models for this process of conversion. This one comes from the book *Forming Intentional Disciples* by Sherry Weddell.



From the Desk of Father Dave

Pretty Nice Outside

The warmer weather makes me think of spring and spring means it's time to get planting. Farmers and gardeners get excited about this and that includes many people around here. The Western Catholic Community has plenty of farmers and gardeners, and we celebrate them.

In our WCC, we are happy to have a small liturgy experience. You can celebrate the Eucharist with around one hundred people at Mass, sometimes a few more, and we invite people to join us. We have the 8:15 Mass that fits the life of a farmer and we have the earliest Mass in the parish on Sunday morning, which seems appealing to some rural folks.

Taking in these facts, I formed a Rural Life Committee in the WCC. We have about seven members that meet with me a couple times a year so that we can offer a few agricultural programs. April 22nd and 23rd we will have a seed blessing where all are asked to bring samples of seeds they want blessed before the planting season. We wonder if some will already be out there, but we will have this blessing in hopes of a productive Spring for all who till the soil. On November 11th and 12th, we will celebrate Harvest Mass Weekend. I thank everyone who made this weekend special last year. This year we hope to add a Youth Communication Contest that includes posters, essays, and any other way to get the message of faith and agriculture out. There will be more details as we draw closer to Harvest Weekend.

If anyone would like to join us in the planning or putting on of these events, please contact me. These activities help define us as Catholics concerned about agriculture. I belong to an organization called Catholic Rural Life that helps promote the Catholic faith in rural areas. I get ideas from them as they are a voice in agriculture today. We need to also be a voice.


