A Face only a Mother could Love

If someone told you, "You have a face only a mother could love," this might not be a compliment. The only time it seems nice is when your own mother says it. I remember being covered head to toe with pig manure and my Mom said something to the effect of, when looking like I did, only a mother could love me. This, of course, was followed by a smile and a laugh just before she told me to clean up. Mothers often have such a bond with their children it doesn't matter much what the face looks like.

Our Mother Mary must have felt like this when her dead son lay in her arms. The look of death along with the remnants of torture must have made our Lord's human face nearly unbearable to look at. Yet it would be pretty easy to imagine that Mary loved Jesus even more as she saw his face. Even if Mary knew the plan of salvation, this would still have been most difficult. She was warned by Simeon at the temple that a dagger would enter her heart and I'm sure she felt that in this tender moment. Her love for lesus is unconditional.

The Blessed Virgin Mary also has unconditional love for us. She continues to shower us with her love as she lives out the purpose of her life. That is to lead us to her Son. 
