From the Desk of Father Dave

20 Years

Compared to many, I'm still pretty young, so there aren't too many things I've done for 20 years. Being a priest is one of them. During that time, there has been much joy and sacrifice, making priesthood a cause of great reflection. On May 31, 1997, I was ordained a priest by Archbishop Harry Flynn at the Cathedral of Saint Paul in St. Paul, Minnesota. I was 32 years old and I had no idea what the future held for me. I spent my first 3 years at Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Maplewood right on the St. Paul border. It was an interesting learning experience that was quite challenging. Sometimes I struggled, but I never lost hope in my vocation. I bounced around to a couple of hospitals in the northern suburbs of Minneapolis and a couple of parishes in St. Paul, but I never quite got my bearings. In between assignments I spent 3 months at St. Mary's in Waverley. Being in the country was good for my soul.

In 2005, I was transferred to Most Holy Redeemer in Montgomery and St. Canice in Kilkenny. Life wasn't perfect, but I was home. These great people are the salt of the earth. I started working with the Knights of Columbus, an organization I really care for. Through it all, I rely on my relationship with Jesus. Jesus is my companion, and I take what I learn from him and apply it to the lives of the people I serve.

In November of 2009, I became part of 3 parishes, St. Scholastica, St. Thomas, and St. Wenceslaus. In 2011, the 5 parish merger became complete, and I was to work with the church sites of St. John in Union Hill along with St. Scholastica and helping some at St. Wenceslaus. Through it all, I never completely left Most Holy Redeemer as I still live in Montgomery, my longest residence after my family farm in Randolph. I have had the pleasure of working with so many great rural people who I've tried to serve. I experienced a devastating illness and even was asked to take a temporary leave because of some actions in my past. The people in the area which I've called home for over half my priesthood stuck with me and loved me. We've had some tough times, but we've had moments of great joy. Please pray for me, all priests, and the church we all love.




