Summer Faith Formation

We have had an exciting two weeks on campus! Summer Faith Formation Plus was "living and active". We had 108 students and 12 catechists who spent the first two weeks of summer learning how to be a disciple of Christ within our Catholic faith tradition.

The children led us in song and worship at five Masses. Besides their regular lessons, various grades also made rosaries, visited the chapel, prayed the rosary in our beautiful Mary garden, toured the church (thank you Darlene Witt), had a reconciliation service, toured Hope House (thank you Kathy Doyle), visited with Father Kevin, learned about the Kerygma, and spent time playing and praying!

We also took on a mission project. This year we chose to help those families who are moving from homelessness into a home. We are doing this through Families Moving Forward, Hope House. Mary Higgins came and talked with our children about how we can help. Families who have been able to finally find affordable housing may not be able to afford all the basic necessities. Our students filled laundry baskets with items that can be given to families as they make this transition. We are happy to be able to assist our brothers and sisters in Christ with this transition.

We know that parents are the primary teachers of their children regarding their faith. Children will listen to what their parents have to say and, more importantly, watch and learn from them. We are thankful to be invited to walk part of this journey with them. Being in community makes us all grow and learn from each other.

From the Desk of Father Dave

Vacation with God

Recently, I was on an 8-day silent directed retreat in Oshkosh, WI. I remember being at a Memorial Day weekend party just before I left and people had said they couldn't make 8 minutes of silence: I wondered if I bit off more than I can chew. I had gone five days before, but eight is a greater challenge. I prayed about this during my long drive to the retreat center.

I arrived at the Jesuit Retreat House on Lake Winnebago and immediately knew this could easily be home for eight days. It was beautiful with many places to pray both indoors and outdoors. After an introductory session where we met our Spiritual Director, we entered into the silence. There were priests, religious sisters, seminarians, youth ministers, and a few men and women who were mostly retired. There were people that had been on these retreats for years and those who were experiencing this for the first time. I "cheated" a couple of times using my cell phone for a few minutes, but for the most part I entered into a media free, work free environment. I really enjoyed the experience of prayer, meals, and liturgies all done with minimal communication. I met daily with a Spiritual director for 45 minutes. She gave me scripture passages that I prayed using my imagination to put myself in the scene.

Journaling came next and then I prayed with my journaling and wrote about that. I looked deep into my life with Jesus and with the people in my life. The silence deepened my life and I found prayer was good most of the time. A few of the scripture passages really challenged me and I had to face some of my demons. Even this hard work was part of that journey that I was able to see God's unconditional love in my life. If anyone feels inclined to participate in a similar retreat I would be happy to share my experience in greater detail. Even if you don't think a retreat of this nature would be for you, I challenge everyone to consider putting more silence into their lives. I believe that God can work in the silence of your hearts if we let him.
