


A Note About Our Faith Formation Program

Disciples of Christ (formerly known as Faith Formation Program)

We are very excited to introduce to you our new Wednesday night Faith Formation. It will be a great year where we join the best of the Western Catholic Community with the best of the Saint Wenceslaus Community to form a united **Disciples of Christ** event for grades 1-8.

We have changed the name from Wednesday night Faith Formation (boring) to reflect that we are not a "program"; we are nurturing a life-long practice of growing as a Disciple of Christ. Our goal is to work alongside our families to help our children know and love Jesus. We will encourage that love through a variety of approaches including; Discipleship time, fun activities, art, classroom discussions, reading God's Word, and various forms of prayer. The spiral curriculum used at each grade level covers: God, Jesus, The Church/Creed, Sacraments, Morality, Prayer, Catholic Social Teaching, and Scripture. Whew ~ we have a lot of ground to cover!

What will our nights look like?

6-6:15 ~ Open gym time for whoever may want to run off a bit of energy or socialize with friends.

 $6:15 \sim \text{All}$ students ready to begin their night! This Discipleship time will vary from week to week. We will have some large group time and some weeks where we meet in smaller groups.

6:25 ~ Catechists will pick up their students and head to the classrooms where they will deepen their understanding of their Catholic faith and come to a greater knowledge of God's great love for them.

7:30 ~ Time to return your children. Parents can meet them in the foyer of the PAC (Parish Activities Center).

We would like to know our numbers so we can get all of our catechists in place. We have many returning catechists from the WCC and the SW sites, but we can always use more. From the Desk of Father Dave

You Have to Put Yourself Out There

When I was a freshman at the University of Minnesota at Waseca in the fall of 1982, I ran for student body treasurer. My opponent was a cute red haired girl with a ton of personality. Heck, if I wasn't running, I probably would have voted for her. I was discouraged about my chances, but my newfound friends insisted that I campaign hard. I'm not sure how many people voted, but I learned I got 81 votes. This was considerably less than my opponent. My friend had a slightly brighter outlook; "You have 80 friends here at school, well actually 79 as I voted twice." Even in a loss I had community, and those days in Waseca shaped me as I grew into adulthood.

God in his mercy gave us the Church. By our baptism we are called to be active. I ask that we all spread the word on being active in our community. If we want to continue to be a Eucharistic community in our church sites, we must work together. We should be faithful stewards in giving time, talent, and treasure in our community. We are going to listen to each other this October and November. We need to motivate great numbers of people to come together and be heard. We are seeking facilitators for this called the Tremendous Ten. These will be members of our community who will lead the listening sessions. We will then ask these facilitators to be a part of the Lenten Discipleship groups that will be for the whole New Prague Area Catholic Community.

We, as a New Prague Area Catholic Community, have the chance to be a parish of intentional disciples. We are working within our own flock to empower people to be active in conversion. People are sharing their faith stories in order to show others that being intentional is possible. I am so excited that the parish has invited me to go to the Catherine of Siena Institute in Colorado Springs. I along with Renee Brod and Stacy Moser will be a part of a workshop to learn more about being intentional disciples and how to bring this back to our community.


