



### From the Desk of Deacon Bob Wagner

### A TIME FOR REMEMBERING

With the Feast of All Saints on November 1st immediately followed by the Feast of All Souls on the 2nd, the month of November takes on a character of remembrance.

In the stained glass windows of St. Wenceslaus, we have a picture gallery of the saints who have gone before us. These saints are our ancient relatives, our baptism, the common DNA that binds us to them.

We don't need to be in church to gaze on pictures of the Church's saints. On the walls of our homes, in our family photo albums, our family's old slides, Super 8 movies, and digital movies, we encounter our own galleries of saint-filled stained glass windows. The family photo albums that my mother and father compiled during their long life together contain my family's own gallery of saints. Pictured in black and white or later in color is my Irish "Grandpap Marron," my maternal grandparents, Oscar and Mary (Marron) Jerstrom, my paternal grandparents, Andrew and Katherine Wojnar, my father at  $1\frac{1}{2}$  years sitting on a chair, and my little sister, Mary, posing with her dog, Pawnee.

We carry within ourselves all the saints that have gone before us. Their DNA has determined the color of our eyes and hair (or lack thereof, in my case), the gifts with which they were blessed, music, cooking, farming, mathematics, writing, and so on, mysteriously passed on to us. Our habits, the way we laugh, our faults, all which makes us who we are, are all traceable to the family saints within our DNA.

As we are linked to them on a cellular level, so we are linked to them on a spiritual level. Every time we celebrate sacraments they are gathered together with us. Every time we rejoice, they share in our joy. Every time we grieve, they share in our sorrow. We can call on them to assist us at anytime. We can call upon their wisdom, and, most importantly, we can call upon them for their prayers.

As we sit around the table at our family celebrations, let us remember them in story and thank them for the gifts they have passed on to us. Let us toast them and remind them, when we pass from this life to the next, to be there to greet us and welcome us home.


