

Moments after Colleen's arrival, our nurse sincerely tried to reassure my wife that her pain was over and she would never have to endure it again, to which Amber quickly quipped, "I can't wait for the next baby that God gives to me." God was listening and gave us 3 more!

I shake my head in awe that for 29 years now my sweet bride has built her life upon giving herself away as a gift to our family. Like our Mother, Mary, her life has been an endless series of "YES" responses. To the hundreds of requests each day which she has responded "YES" to "wash the feet" of our family and others, she has indeed made a lasting impression. Now, those same children whose mother welcomed them with such enthusiasm are crafting their own greatest hopes and career paths around the primacy of the gift of holy marriage and the blessing of parenthood.

Although I'm not so young anymore, my eyes still mist when I remember running off of the school bus each day knowing that my own mom would be sitting at the kitchen table waiting for us. When Mom passed away this past July, all of us kids recalled this vivid image and mused that now Mom would be waiting for us in Heaven. Strangely enough, that has not been my experience since her "departure." I have actually never felt my mom closer to me in my life. Now, rather than waiting for me, I feel her walking with me every moment until I make it home.

The salvation of the world began with Mother Mary's "YES", and the "YES" of every mother since only renews Christ's victory. A mother's love remains unapologetic, undefeated, and unending.

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

My father died early in the morning on November 13, 2004. I remember sitting dumbstruck next to his lifeless body. My father was the wisdom figure of the family, which included not only my own nuclear family but all his nieces and nephews and their spouses and children. They would call from all over the United States seeking his wisdom and knowledge, and now he was gone. I was not only dumbstruck by the loss of my father, but by the realization that my role in the family had undergone a dramatic change. I was no longer a "kid", anymore. The mantle of leadership and the wisdom, that hopefully accompanies leadership, had been passed on to me. There are many people who have experienced this same dramatic change in their lives as their parents died. The one question I believe we all ask is, "Are we up to the task of being the leaders of our families?"

I am sure the apostles were thinking similar thoughts as they watched Jesus ascend to the Father. Jesus entrusted to them the mission he had of proclaiming the Good News to people everywhere. I love the reaction of the angel in the Acts of the Apostles who basically tells the apostles to quit gawking at the empty sky into which Jesus ascended and get busy fulfilling the mission of Jesus. As we hear in the Gospel account, the apostles did exactly that, going forth to preach the Good News to everyone.

As Jesus entrusted his mission to the apostles, so the apostles have entrusted the same mission to generation after generation up to our present time. Today the angel from the Acts of the Apostles tells us to quit standing around and get busy proclaiming the Good News in word and in action. This mission is not isolated to just a few "holy people" but is entrusted to all who have been baptized.

In a recent conversation with my cousin, Kathy, I was touched to hear that my dad, when he was alive, often spoke highly of me to her, saying that I was his twin. May Jesus say the same of us as we continue his mission to our world.

Why Second Stork?

Each year, thousands of new parents across Minnesota are stretched to bring their baby home from the hospital with even the most basic supplies such as a safe place to sleep, diapers, wet wipes, clothing, receiving blankets, and other essential items. Founded in 2009, Second Stork is a Minnesota non-profit that fulfills this real, immediate need by providing those critical items free of charge with no strings attached. Items in critical need now are:

- * Sleepers one-piece, footed sleepers in sizes Preemie (P), Newborn (NB), or 0-3 months (size 3 months is OK too, but 3-6 months is too big)
- * Onesies one-piece t-shirt/bodysuit in sizes Preemie (P), Newborn (NB), or 0-3 months (size 3 months is OK too, but 3-6 months is too big)
- * Receiving Blankets light blankets, cotton or flannel only.
- * Diapers as you can imagine, are also a critical part of the items provided to families in need. Second Stork provides diaper packs in addition to the layettes. We need sizes Preemie, Size 1, or Newborn.

All donated items must be new as hospitals cannot distribute used items. Only the sizes specified above should be collected, as these items are essential for the first 30 days; many infants wear these items home from the hospital.
