





From the Desk of Deacon Bob

"Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you."

Throughout the Gospel of John, Jesus speaks of the abundance of God's generosity. With the woman at the well, Jesus speaks of giving her water so that she will never thirst again. To the people in the Gospel today, Jesus tells them that he can give them bread so that they will never hunger again. Later, Jesus will promise his disciples an abundance of God's peace, a peace that the world can never give to them.

Humanity has spent lifetimes pursuing the goal of never being hungry, never being thirsty, seeking peace and security in human life. We hear about the "American Dream", and many misinterpret this "Dream" as the ability of a person to personally amass and hoard a great deal of wealth. If we examine the lives of those who follow this false doctrine, we find extremely unhappy people. They can never acquire enough to ever satisfy them. They grasp for more and more and their hands continue to come up empty. The emptiness of this Gospel of Prosperity is that we cannot buy or own the abundance of God. The abundance of God cannot be earned nor stolen. The abundance of God is freely given to us by God.

The secret to never being hungry or thirsty again; the secret to finding the peace that Jesus promises, is that the abundance we receive from God must be given away to others, especially to those who are most in need. This is the "Holy Poverty" of which St Francis of Assisi preached and lived. It was not seeking to be poor and destitute, but rather realizing that all we are and receive from God is a Divine gift that is meant to be shared. The more we share the abundance that God gives to us, the more we will receive in abundance from God.

Every time we receive Holy Communion we must feel compelled, as the baptized Body of Christ, to go forth from Mass and share the abundance of God we have received with others.
