Teach us to discover the worth of each thing,

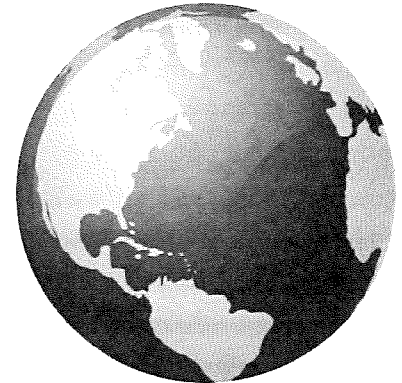
to be filled with awe and contemplation,

From the Desk of Ruth Weinandt**Stepping Outside of My Comfort Zone**

For 12 years I have been working at St. Wenceslaus in dual roles of Accounting and Faith Formation where I have felt, well.... comfortable. I am not saying it wasn't challenging or enjoyable or meaningful; it has always been all of those, but also comfortable.

Life was good, but then, when I least expected a change – I felt a nudge. This nudge would take me out of my comfort zone and into the challenging, enjoyable, and meaningful area of Pastoral Ministry. Here is the problem...I have a fear of being in front of people. This is not just an ordinary fear; I sort of have an out-of-body experience and a want-to-run-out-of-the-room kind of fear. In Pastoral Ministry, I am expected to be in front of people during various liturgies and group discussions, etc. FEAR! Now what do I do?

Jesus does not call us to be comfortable; he calls us to be disciples. For the early disciples, that meant going away from what they knew, and focusing on their faith in Jesus. In Matthew's Gospel 14:26-29....Jesus called on his disciple Peter to walk on water during a storm. Peter was terrified, but he stepped out in faith. When he focused on Jesus, he was fine, but when he takes his eyes off Jesus, he notices the fierce wind and he sinks.

Being a disciple means I am going to step out in faith and trust (and fear) into my new position as Pastoral Minister. (I am keeping the Accounting position also ~ it is my sanity.) Following Jesus can be scary and difficult, but it will certainly be a great adventure. I won't walk on water, but if you see me running from a room full of people ~ just wait, I will be back when I turn my focus back to Jesus and away from fear.

Shepherd me oh God, beyond my wants, beyond my fears...

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

Today, we hear Peter say to Jesus, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." We live in a world that is very broken. Equally, we live in a Church that is broken. It always has been this way. This struck home hard once more, all the more with the exposure of the massive abuse of children by priests and the bishops complicit in covering up these crimes in the State of Pennsylvania. This report reopened, for me, the wounds caused by the history of sexual abuse of children by priests and its cover-up by bishops in our own Archdiocese.

In the introduction to the Sacrament of Penance, it is written that the Church, as a human institution, is always in need of conversion. It matters not whether we are laity, professed religious, deacons, priests, bishops, cardinals, or even the Pope, we are all sinners and in need of conversion. One only has to study the history of the Church to see that it has never been the perfect society. From the time of the apostles to our present age, there has been conflict within the Church.

If the Church is so in need of conversion, where do we go to find "the words of eternal life?" People quit going to Church for many reasons, bad experiences with clergy, bishops, the closing of church sites, to name just a few. What do we mean by the word "Church"? The Church, from its very inception, has always been the community of faith, the *sensus fidelium*. Not one Pope, bishop, priest, deacon, professed religious, or physical church site has ever encompassed "the Church". We ALL are the Church. As the physical, breathing Body of Christ on this Earth, we, collectively, must go to Jesus, the Head of the Church, to hear his words of eternal life. Jesus' words of eternal life emerge from within our faith community in our prayer, song, and our reception of the sacraments at Mass. To cut ourselves off from the community of faith creates a state of deafness to God's word in our lives.

The institutional Church will always be in need of conversion. Like the apostles, we have a choice to make. Do we walk away from the Church? Or do we say with Peter, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."

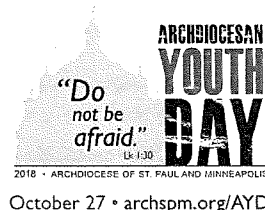
Join Youth Ministry in a Special Opportunity on September 5th

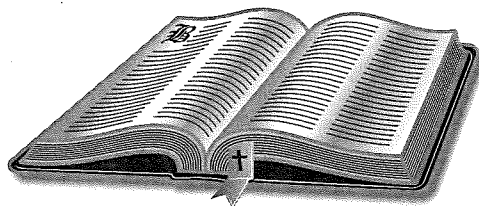

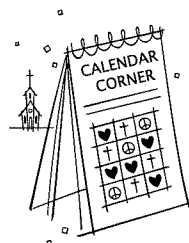
