### From the Desk of Deacon Bob

On September 24, 1994, 24 years ago, I received the sacrament of Holy Orders as a deacon. Ordination is like getting married, only the guest list is larger and I got to wear the long, white dress. As in marriage, my life was utterly changed forever. Prior to ordination, my life was 75% private and 25% public. Post ordination, it became 25% private and 75% public. A beloved mentor, Deacon Dick Barrett, explained to lay Church ministers, "You can decide to stay in church ministry or leave church ministry. I cannot. I will be a deacon for the rest of my life."

A priest is often described as "Christ as Sacrament." A deacon is described as "Christ as Servant." The apostles established the order of deacon (see Acts of the Apostles chapter 6) to assist the needs of the Greek widows, orphans, and the poor. Our ministry is service to others, 24/7. Deacons continue to serve the most vulnerable in society. Generally, people only see the deacon at Mass. That's only 10% of our ministry. The other 90% is done outside of Mass. We never go home after work. We are always at work, even at times as mundane as picking up milk at the store.

I have found the biggest challenge in being a deacon is balancing the needs of those I serve with the needs of my own family. In the past 24 years, there have been many family meals, school events of my children and grandchildren, and games I missed because I am doing diaconal ministry. My family, in agreeing to my ordination, sacrificed their time with me. The grace of being married and raising a family has assisted me greatly in my ministry to families, which is why I wear clerics only on occasion, e.g. funerals and weddings. A simple deacon's cross suffices for I am one with those I serve.

In the first reading Moses exclaims, "Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets!" In the Gospel, Jesus says, "There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us." Not everyone is called by God to Holy Orders. However, all who are baptized have been called to be ministers of Jesus. Will we answer the call?

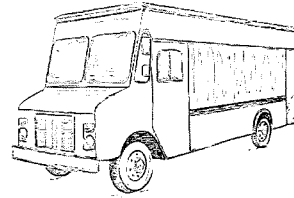
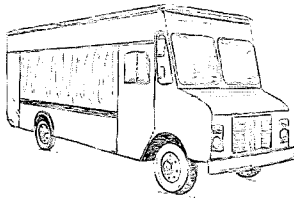
**Saint Francis of Assisi, Pray for Us**

On Oct. 4, the Catholic Church celebrates the memorial of one of its most recognized and beloved saints, Saint Francis of Assisi. 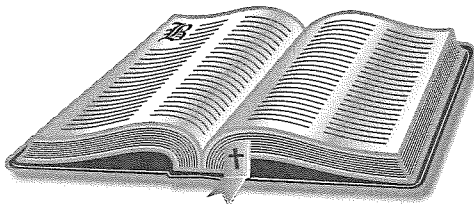

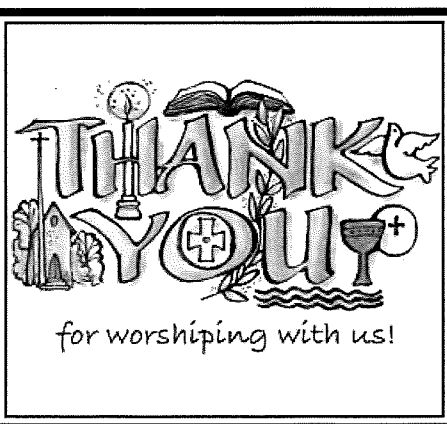
