



From the Desk of Father Kevin

With the Light of God Lighting the Way We Proclaim "Good News" to an often Dark World

Great joy might not be the best description of today's world two thousand years after the Messiah's birth: tribal conflicts continue in Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan, and African countries; millions flee their homeland as refugees; acts of terrorism; shootings take place regularly in our schools and cities.

Today's message of "great "joy or the Christian message of Good News is not the usual human story. Often today bad news dominates our communities and world. There also may be sad news in many of our families. We could well ask, "Shepherds, why your jubilee? Why your songs of joyful cheer? What great brightness do you see? What good tidings do you hear?"

Bringing joy, peace, and justice to the world is, in part, left to us Christians. God sent us God's Son to become like us \sim a human person \sim and our Messiah. Jesus Christ brought through the cross the forgiveness of our sins and our redemption. The possibility for eternal life has been offered to all people.

But God also sends us and commissions us \sim as the Body of Christ \sim to be Christ to others. The biblical story of sin and division began between two brothers: Cain and Abel. It could have been two sisters, two friends, two fellow workers, or two spouses. Some of us don't even need another person for such hostility to arise, for sometimes we don't even like ourselves.

The presence of the Risen Lord in us and through us causes us to rightly bring "good news" to the world's darkness. In the here and now, glad tidings of great joy come alive when we learn to love ourselves better and care for others ~ yes, even our enemies.

We proclaim good news of great joy!

...Looking forward to tax time?

Have you lost the ability to deduct your contributions since the new tax laws have increased the standard deduction? There are options for you to give to our church and receive a tax deduction.

- 1. Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD). Owners of IRAs who are at least age 70½ can contribute some or all of their IRA's distribution to charity. An IRA has a required minimum distribution after you turn 70½ ~ this amount is taxed as ordinary income, UNLESS you process the distribution as a QCD!
- 2. Donor Advised Funds (DAF). You may be able to deposit current and future contributions into a DAF. The amount deposited may be over the threshold that would allow you to itemize the total this current year; while holding the funds in the sponsored DAF for future contributions.

Please check with your tax and/or financial advisor for details and to see if these tax options work for you (and for our church).

St. John's Feast Day


Fr. Theisen will celebrate Mass on Thurs., Dec. 27th at 6 pm at St. John's. It is the Titular Feast Day for the church and thus is raised to the level of a Solemnity. A Plenary Indulgence is attached to those who celebrate this Solemnity through visiting the Church and devoutly reciting the "Our Father" and the "Creed" (which we will do during the Mass). In addition, to gain the Plenary Indulgence, one must have the intention of gaining the indulgence and meet the following 3 conditions: 1. Make a sacramental confession, 2. Receive our Lord in Eucharistic Communion, and 3. Make a prayer for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff (the Pope). These 3 conditions may be met several days before or after the Solemn Feast Day. Fr. Theisen will make himself available for Confession on that day 45 minutes before Mass.




