Padre's Pen ~ Happy Mother's Day

Regarding motherhood, G.K. Chesterton wrote, "How can it be a large career to tell other people's children about the Rule of Three, and a small career to tell one's own children about the universe? How can it

be broad to be the same thing to everyone, and narrow to be everything to someone? No; a woman's function is laborious, but because it is gigantic, not because it is minute. I will pity Mrs. Jones for the hugeness of her task; I will never pity her for its smallness."

Dearest mothers, you do indeed have a gigantic task. The nurturing and protecting of life in a womb is but the beginning of a life-changing vocation that comes with a name change. It is no easy task to go from Sue, or Karen, or Annette to "Mommy." Mom's aren't specialists unless you want to call self-sacrificing love a "specialization." Mom's change culture one diaper at a time. They fix hurts and scrapes with a kiss and a Bandaid. They make us children eat our vegetables and take our vitamins, and then they give up the last piece of cake because, "Mommy really isn't hungry." Mom's pick us up and drop us off at all our sporting events and extra-curricular activities. Moms must be all things; not to all people, but to the children of her own flesh and blood.

The mystic Julian of Norwich writes, "The kind, loving mother who knows and sees the need of her child guards it very tenderly, as the nature and condition of motherhood will have." And she continues that this is, in its essence, a participation in the lifegiving action of Christ. And since it is a participation in Christ, it is a huge task that is beyond a woman's individual capacity to fulfill. Motherhood is a task with eternal consequences.

So, we honor all our mothers this day and we ask God's blessing upon them. We thank our mothers for the gift of our lives. We pray that our loving God who submitted himself to the authority of a mother in his Incarnation will repay in eternity our mothers who so willingly sacrifice for us.

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

The fourth Sunday of Easter is usually designated "Good Shepherd" Sunday. Over the three year cycle of readings during Easter, we often hear Jesus speak about his role as the Good Shepherd of humanity. He is the one who will leave his flock to go look for the lost sheep. He is the one ready to lay down his life for his sheep. He identifies those qualities that make a good shepherd and warns us not to follow those shepherds who would abandon their sheep to the wolves.

Universally for all Christians, Jesus is the Shepherd of all humanity. Roman Catholic Christians will assign the Pope the role of Shepherd of the Church. Cross denominationally, most Christians will see the pastors of their parishes as their shepherds. It is a mistake to look upon only the ordained as being shepherds. Historically in the Christian Church, and recently within our own Archdiocese, many we assumed to be our Good Shepherds have been revealed instead to be wolves dressed in shepherd's clothing.

Baptized into Christ, we were intimately joined to Jesus, the Good Shepherd. The DNA of Jesus, the Good Shepherd, is a major part of our own DNA. St Paul writes that when we put on Christ at our baptism, our bodies were absorbed within the Body of Jesus. Our bodies are His Body. It is the breath of Jesus we breathe. His blood flows within our veins. As the living and breathing Body of Christ on this earth, we are all called to be Good Shepherds to one another. As Good Shepherds, we are to love, to support, to guide, to protect, and to provide for the needs of all humanity, who are the flock of Jesus.

Under this umbrella of Jesus the Good Shepherd, parents, be Good Shepherds to your children. Children, be Good Shepherds to your parents, and, brothers and sisters. Within our parish, priests, deacons, parish staff be Good Shepherds to your parishioners. Parishioners, be Good Shepherds to your priests, deacons, and parish staff. Within our community, neighbors, be Good Shepherds to those in your neighborhood. For our mayor, and all occupying responsibilities within our city (council members, employees, police, firefighters, EMTs) be Good Shepherds to those you are called to serve. Citizens be Good Shepherds and fulfill your civic responsibilities to those who serve you. This is what we do as Good Shepherds.




