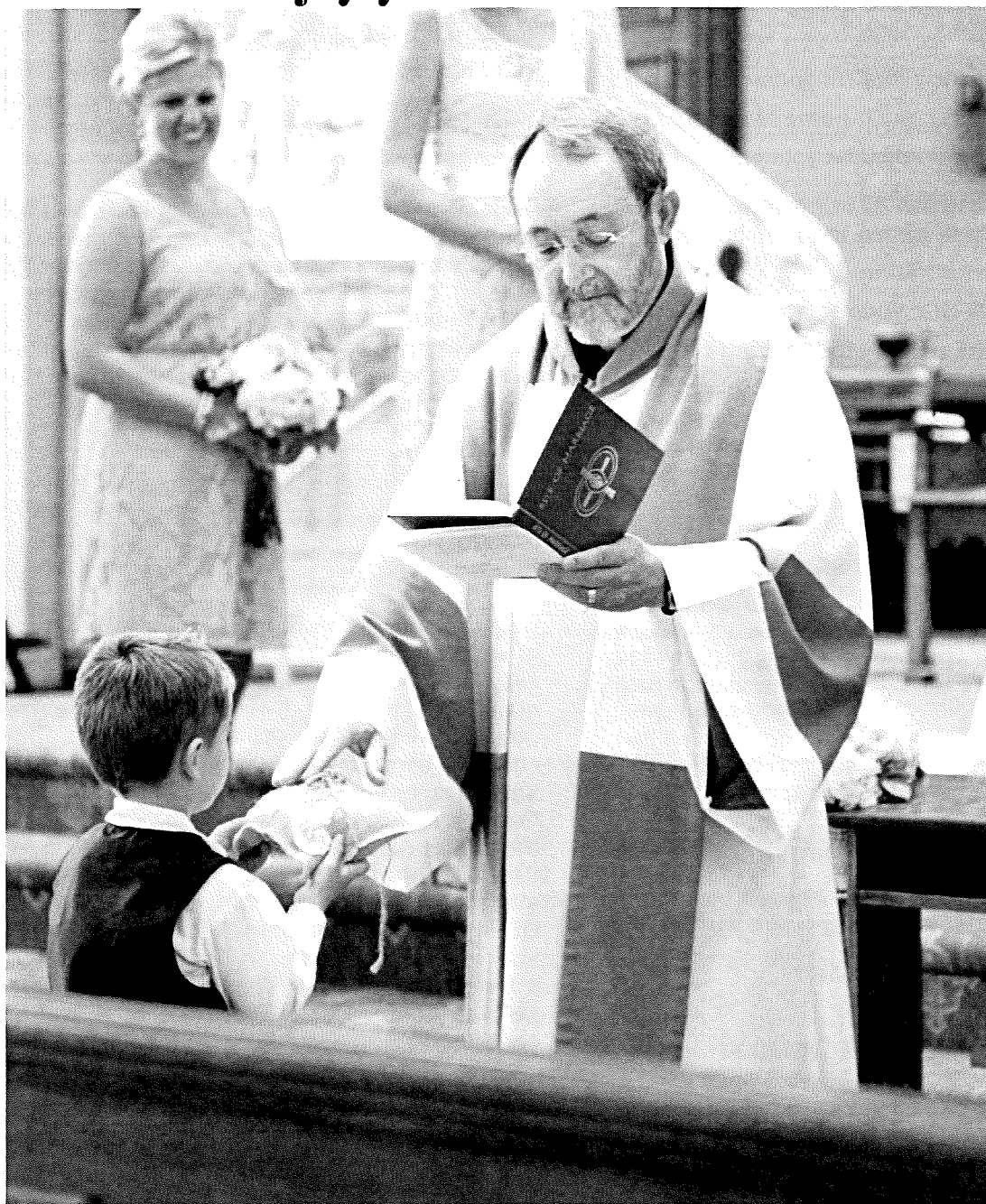

From the Desk of Father Kevin**45 Years and Retirement
How did I get here?**

On this weekend of June 2, 2019, I reflect on the passage of 45 years as an ordained priest to serving people in their parish. I am stunned that 45 years have passed by. It doesn't seem like that amount of time at all. Oh, there are LOTS of stories to tell; lots of bewildering experiences along the way which at the time seemed overwhelming. But here I am 45 years later ~ BUT BY THE GRACE OF GOD am I here.

Certainly, I have much to be thankful for. I have been with the people of the New Prague Area Catholic Community for 14½ years. Weekend and weekday liturgies, homilies, Christmases & Easters, weddings, graduations, baptisms, funerals, etc. by the 100s. No one week was the same as the other. I was never bored. Many people helped me with their counsel and support all along the way. With staff and parish leaders we tried our best to discern and act on the common good of the people. While challenges have been complex and often of great consequence, we have tried to know the needs of the community, access what the real-world facts were, and then act on them. By no means did I feel isolated and alone in making decisions. I am very grateful for this. I accomplished very little by myself. The good things that happened involved many people working together.

With the conclusion of my serving as pastor and the beginning of retirement, I have very mixed feelings. This change is not easy. So much of my life's relationships have been in the many activities of a parish. It is also true for me that "most of my life was just 'showing up' for things". That is about to significantly change. After June 2nd and formally after June 30th, I will no longer have the responsibility of being a pastor. I will "let go" so that my successor and others may take up the responsibilities that were mine. The time has arrived. I am 70½ years old. It is time to "shift gears". I am in good health, but now begins the stage of life where my life responsibilities get narrower and DEEPER at the same time. Jesus of Nazareth was engaged in a very active public ministry for 3 years and then he experienced a transformation that shared with others the very things that he was doing. He passed from their sight, but the mission continued.

So, if 45 years ago started a journey, most of which happened "but by the grace of God", I now begin another phase of my human life ~ still very much a human being who is working at being a Christian and will continue now as a retired ordained priest. I will be OK because the hand of God has always caught me (often in surprising ways) and has never dropped me. The people of the church have regularly witnessed this to me.

I look forward to the coming days and I thank all of you for allowing me to share my life with you as your priest. I thank you for enriching mine in so many ways!

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

While they (the disciples) were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven."

Think of the extraordinary events that the disciples experienced. They traveled with Jesus as he taught, healed, and performed miracles like the feeding of the 5,000 and the calming of the storm at sea. Then they witnessed Jesus' arrest, torture, and execution. And, then, the *crème de le crème* event, Jesus rises from the dead and interacts with them again. Is it any wonder, that as Jesus ascended into heaven, they stood there gawking into the sky? Yet, the angels gently reprimand them by saying essentially, "Quit your gawking and twiddling your thumbs. You've got work to do." The angels' gentle reprimand is addressed to us, as well.

I remember arriving at the hospital shortly after my father had died. My dad was the wisdom figure of not only my own family, but of all our extended family on the East Coast. Dad was constantly being called and asked for his counsel. As I sat next to my dad's lifeless body, I thought to myself, "The wisdom figure of my family has died." Then it suddenly dawned on me, "Oh my God! Now I am supposed to be the wisdom figure of the family! Man, everyone is so SOL!" The torch my father had carried in life had been passed on to me at his death. The time had come for me to grow up and carry on the legacy of my father.

It falls not only to a small group of individuals to carry on the saving mission of Jesus. The mission of Jesus has been passed on to all of us! It is now our responsibility to allow God's Reign to enter our world through us. Our "mission field" is our homes, our places of work, and our communities. Jesus has no use for "lazy" disciples who sit around "twiddling their thumbs". The Feast of the Ascension reminds us that it is time for us to "grow up" and carry on the saving mission of Jesus.

Feast of Corpus Christi

The Feast of Corpus Christi (the Body and Blood of Christ) began in 1246 in France and became a feast for the entire Western Church in 1264. It was meant to be a celebration of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharistic feast (Holy Mass.) Corpus Christi processions were held at St. John's until the early 1950's. About 15 years ago, the tradition began again. Parishioners decorate altars outside the church, the Sunday congregation process along as Eucharistic hymns and songs are sung while the priest carries the Blessed Sacrament to each of the altars. We invite you to join in this Holy celebration of Christ's real presence in the Eucharist on Sun., June 23rd at St. John's following the 10 am Mass.

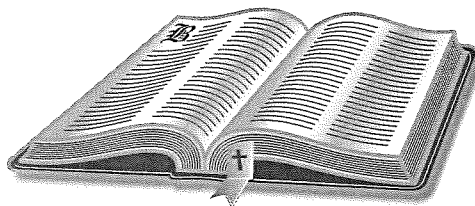

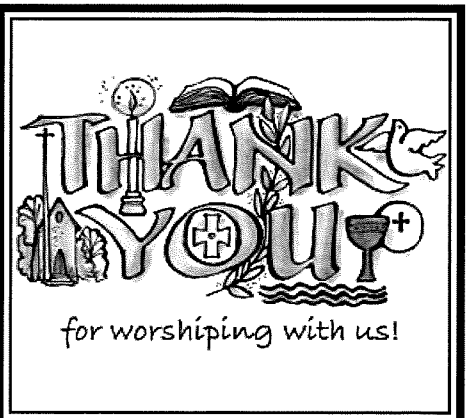
