

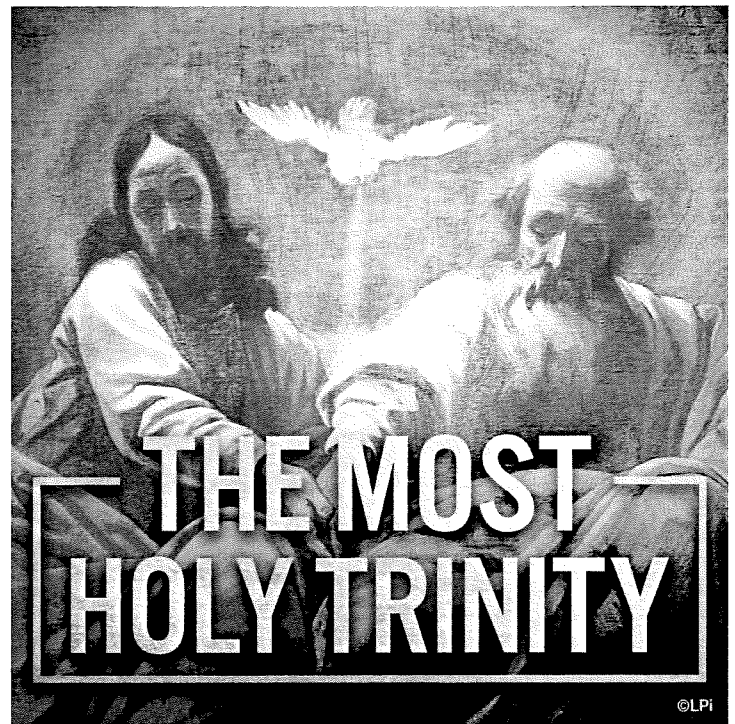

## A Father's Day Note...

### **My dad never told me that he loved me.....**

It was a long time ago when I was young, and people weren't as free about verbally expressing their feelings as they might be now. I never had any doubt about the fact that he loved me. I don't think I imagined how much, until I became a parent myself and could then experience that intense love that you have for your own child.

**I was blessed** to have that fun dad. He loved telling stories, reciting *Casey at the Bat*, playing little tricks on people or taking our three-year-old for a ride to New York (which was really only St. Benedict). His joyful, playful temperament was put on hold for some time as he grieved the death of his 20-year-old son from a heat stroke in Army basic training. At that time, there was no doubt about the love for his child. His strong faith brought him through and, eventually, back to his fun loving personality. He died very suddenly, and I never had the chance to tell him what a good dad I thought he was.

**I was blessed** to marry and enjoy seeing my husband being a dad. He could hardly wait until the end of the work day to be in the house to hold, or feed, or simply gaze at the new baby. Rides in the wheelbarrow for the toddlers or simply having the little people by his side on the farm never lost its enjoyment for him. Being a good dad was not always easy. Sometimes those sons got off the road (sometimes literally!). Tough love had to kick in more than once. That's when it was good to have a strong personality with the faith and courage to set hard rules and stick to them. He was much better at that than I was.....I have a great admiration for single parents who go it alone.

**I was blessed** to be able to watch my own sons become fathers. Now they, too, through loving their own children, have a glimmer of what God's love for us must be. I probably don't tell them often enough that they are doing a good job at one of the most important tasks in life.

Faith and family prayer, even when it sometimes seemed awkward, has been the mainstay of these three generations.

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY to all dad's.....biological, as well as all of you who have guided and encouraged young people on their journeys.

### From the Desk of Deacon Bob

In a Confirmation at St. Wenceslaus in the early 80's, the confirmandi stood as Archbishop Roach prayed, invoking the Holy Spirit to come down upon them. As he prayed, what appeared to be a bird appeared and soared over the heads of the confirmandi. Upon closer examination, it wasn't a dove flying over their heads. It was a bat. Apparently, the Archbishop's prayer awakened a bat up in the choir loft, and the bat decided to check out all the activity below in the church. It was all rather amusing as ushers grabbed the collection baskets and chased the bat up and down the aisles eventually into one of the bell towers.

The most ancient Hebrew symbol of God's Spirit in Hebrew scriptures is not a dove (nor a bat). It is the breath of God. God breathed upon the waters in Genesis, and life came forth. *Ruah* is the Hebrew word for God's breath. It is the Wind from all 4 directions that restored a valley of bones to life in the book of Ezechial. It is God's Wind roaring through the streets of Jerusalem that fills the upper room on Pentecost day. The dove as a symbol, heavily influenced by Greek mythology, came much later.

As I finished up my studies to be a spiritual director, I spent five days at a hermitage located on a lake. It was early May, and nature was blossoming everywhere. I spent most of my solitude on the shore of that lake, meditating. I observed how the wind moved the clouds in the sky and the waters on the lake. Remembering how God breathed upon the waters in Genesis, I marveled that the Holy Spirit is God's life force in the world. It is God's breath that moves the clouds and causes the waves upon the lake. God's Spirit is above us, below us, and to the sides of us. As I took a deep breath, I became aware that it is God's breath that I was breathing. We are never isolated from God's Holy Spirit. Rather, we move, live, and have our being *within the Spirit of God*.

God's Spirit is not trapped in some church building. The Holy Spirit is all around us. On this Pentecost, walk outside. Listen to nature. Feel the breeze on your skin. Take a deep breath and become aware of God's Spirit around and within you.

### URGENT REQUEST FROM ARCHBISHOP HEBDA

Recently Archbishop Hebda asked for help with this year's Catholic Services Appeal. The Appeal funds a wide variety of ministries across the archdiocese. Maybe due to the bad weather during the Appeal Weekend or other factors, the Appeal is running about \$800,000 behind where it was last year at this time. In addition to providing funding for our schools, Catholic Charities, and our seminaries, it also funds for the first time Abria Pregnancy Resource Center and the Society of St. Vincent de Paul; these help those in crisis pregnancy and the poorest of the poor in our greater metropolitan area of St. Paul and Minneapolis.

We are running behind somewhat where we were as a parish last year in both the number of donors and the amount pledged. If we haven't heard from you yet, we ask that you respond to the Archbishop's request. Please be assured that your contributions to the Appeal are used only to fund those programs listed in the Appeal.

If you would like to make a contribution, envelopes will be available in the back of church. They may be turned over the next couple of weeks in the collection basket or by mailing them to the parish office. Thank you to all those who have helped our parish raise over \$27,000. Any payment or pledge received would be greatly appreciated.

### The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June is the month devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. How fitting to have it follow the month devoted to our Blessed Mother Mary, being as May leads into June, Mary leads us to the love, symbolized by His heart, of her Son. We find Jesus' Sacred Heart of love revealed most profoundly in the Blessed Sacrament. God's giving of Himself, the Eucharist, is joyously celebrated on the Feast of Corpus Christi, which will be observed this year on June 23rd. Devotion to the Eucharist and the Sacred Heart of Jesus are entwined as is the mystery of Jesus' human love and divine love. St. Peter Julian Eymard instructs us, "Let us learn to honor the Sacred Heart in the Eucharist. Let us never separate them."

### Feast of Corpus Christi

The Feast of Corpus Christi (the Body and Blood of Christ) began in 1246 in France and became a feast for the entire Western Church in 1264. It was meant to be a celebration of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharistic feast (Holy Mass.) Corpus Christi processions were held at St. John's until the early 1950's. About 15 years ago, the tradition began again. Parishioners decorate altars outside the church, the Sunday congregation process along as Eucharistic hymns and songs are sung while the priest carries the Blessed Sacrament to each of the altars. We invite you to join in this Holy celebration of Christ's real presence in the Eucharist on Sun., June 23rd at St. John's following the 10 am Mass.

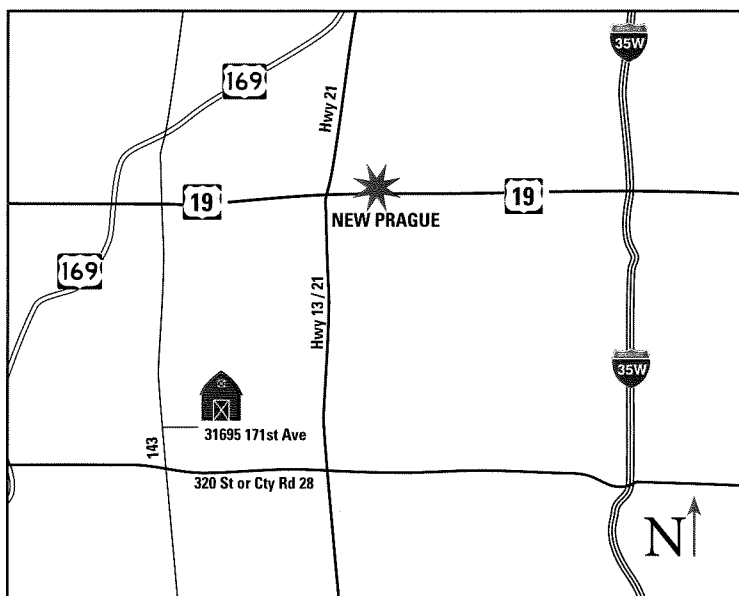

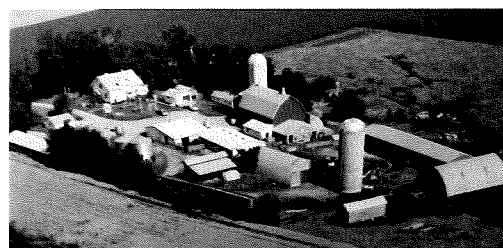
