





From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen



Padre's Pen

- Great to be Catholic

Way back in the Fall of 1997 I was entering my third year of graduate theology. That fall semester we had the great privilege

of spending a semester in the Holy Land. We lived in an old Coptic Orthodox Convent in the Old City Jerusalem right next door to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. It was a very blessed time travelling around the Holy Land, studying architecture, archeology, going to holy sites, and praying in places that we hear about in the sacred scriptures.

One of the greatest blessings was the ability to almost daily go to pray in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. I would sit on a little bench up on Mount Calvary (Calvary and the Tomb are both encompassed within the church) and pray my liturgy of the hours, rosary, and/or just read/contemplate. I have to admit that initially I got frustrated and angry. There was a constant line of people coming and going. Some were very respectful, others were not. The pinnacle of my frustration came one afternoon when a tour guide brought his group up and began to talk.

Mount Calvary is divided in two. On one side is the Orthodox altar and on the other side is the Catholic altar. On the Catholic side is a large mosaic depicting the crucifixion with our Blessed Mother, John, and Mary Magdalene. Of note, the mosaic of Mary Magdalene does not have a halo around her head. This is where the tour guide annoyed me. He boldly stated that they were on the Catholic side and that Mary Magdalene did not have a halo because the Catholic Church did not consider her a saint. I about went through the roof, but I showed self-restraint and continued with my prayers.

Saint Mary Magdalene's feast day is 22 July. It was not the proper time or place to address the tour guide's misconception. Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen used to say that he didn't believe there were more than 100 people in the U.S. who knew what the Catholic Church was and still hated her, but that there were thousands and thousands who have a hatred for her based on misconceptions and false information.

My time in the Holy Land and especially my time up on Calvary changed me and the way I look at Scripture and the great Tradition we have in the Church. We have the fullness of truth as revealed to us by God for the salvation of the world. We don't have to fight every battle because the war is already won by Christ himself, but it behooves us to know and love the faith passed on to us and be examples of the peace of Christ dwelling in our hearts.


