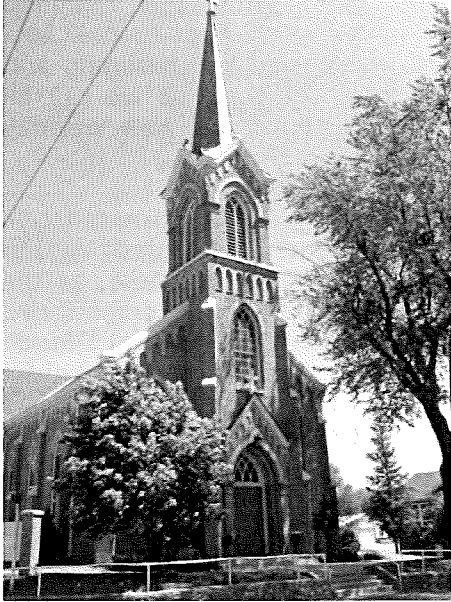

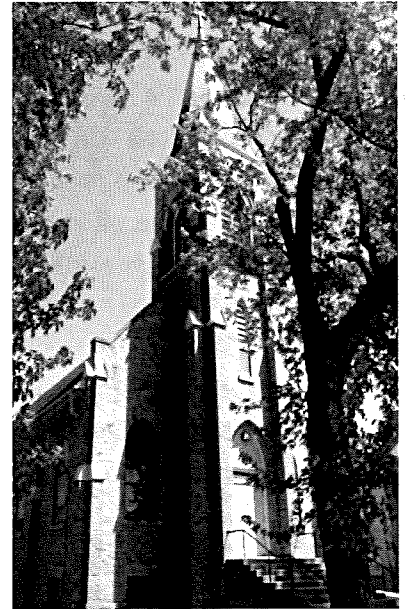

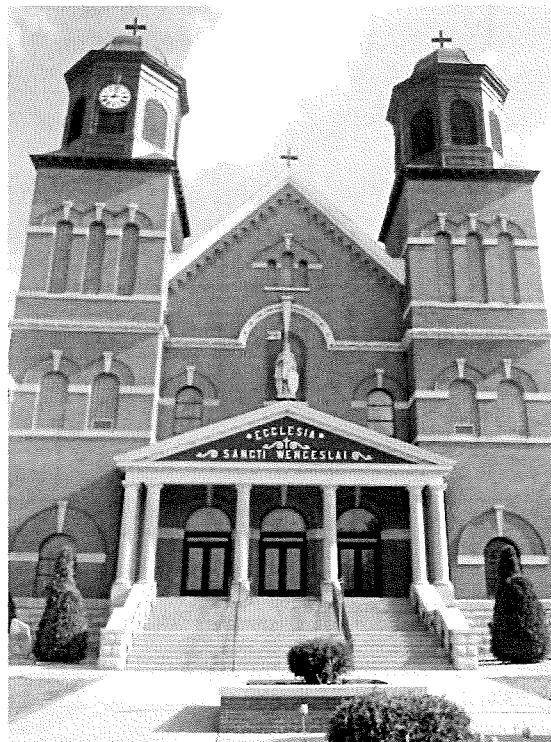

From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**Padre's Pen****– The Mass, Part 1**

My dearest people, if you haven't figured it out yet, the worthy and dignified celebration of the Holy Mass is very important to me. So I plan to spend some time with my column just outlining and teaching about this great gift from our Lord, so we can all better understand what it is we are doing and how we may better participate in the sacred mysteries.

The "Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy" (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*) and other documents from the Second Vatican Council reveal to us that, "The celebration of Mass, as the action of Christ and of the People of God arrayed hierarchically, is the center of the whole of Christian life for the Church both universal and local, as well as for each of the faithful individually." (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 16). The first and most important thing I want to point out is that the celebration of the Holy Mass is an action of Christ united with His people. He does more in the celebration of Mass than all of us combined in the world. Thus, each and every Mass has an infinite value.

Our participation in the Holy Mass is ordered that all the faithful take part according to the state proper to each. The easiest example for this (though not an exclusive example) is the difference between the priest and the lay faithful. All are members of the Body of Christ and function in the diverse ways analogically as the various parts of a body function in diverse ways to make the whole. In the Church, there is one priesthood. It is the priesthood of Christ who is head of the body. The ordained priest receives the character of Christ's priesthood in him in the way that St. Paul affirms when he says that, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ in me." The ministerial priesthood is a participation in the headship of Christ. Thus, we get the theological conclusion that the priest acts in *persona Christi*, "in the person of Christ."

One of the practical results that you will see of this longstanding theological conclusion and teaching of the Church is that you will see our servers bowing (and me as well) in acknowledgement of the presence of Christ in that particular way, and in acknowledgment back when the servers are setting and serving the altar itself. The hope, prayer, and long-term goal is that the more we acknowledge Christ in the tabernacle, at the altar, in each other, then the closer He will draw to us and make himself known and loved on a deeper level.

Bottom line... all we do, say, hear, think in our sacred liturgies is about Christ.

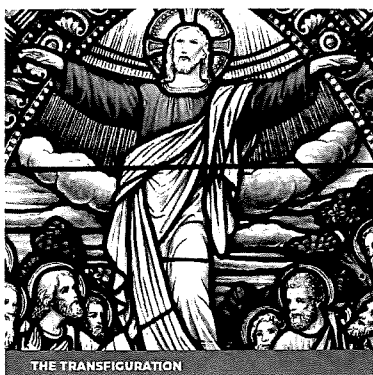

The Transfiguration

How are we to understand the Transfiguration? The story of the Transfiguration is also proclaimed on the second Sunday of Lent ~ a key part of Jesus' journey towards the Cross. The Catechism of the Catholic Church draws parallels between Jesus' Baptism and the Transfiguration. Jesus is baptized at the start of his public ministry. His baptism proclaims the mystery of our first regeneration ~ we die and rise again with Christ. The "Transfiguration 'is the sacrament of the second regeneration': our own Resurrection (St. Thomas Aquinas, STh III, 45, 4, ad 2). From now on we share in the Lord's Resurrection through the Spirit who acts in the sacraments of the Body of Christ. The Transfiguration gives us a foretaste of Christ's glorious coming, when he 'will change our lowly body to be like his glorious body (Phil 3:21)'" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 556).

During the Prayer after Communion, we pray that God might "transform us into the likeness of your [his] Son, / whose radiant splendor you willed to make manifest / in his glorious Transfiguration." The Collect, or opening prayer, tells us that the mystery of the Transfiguration "prefigures our full adoption to sonship." The Transfiguration, initially revealed to Peter, James, and John, reveals to all of us a taste of what is yet to come. The Transfiguration is the fourth of the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary. 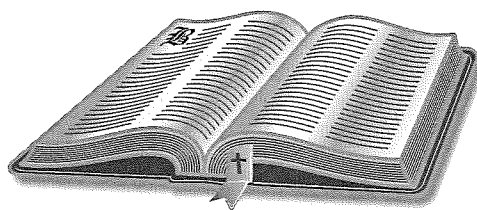
