From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen



<u>Padre's Pen</u> – "Thank You!" and The Mass, Part IV – Reverencing the Altar and Greeting

Again, I begin by saying "Thank You" to all the people who responded to fixing the organ. We have gone over the goal I set! We have collected just over \$10,500 as I write this on Monday morning. I am humbled by the outpouring of support and the number of people who would like to see our pipe organ back in use for our worship, school concerts, weddings, and special liturgies.

As the opening music draws to a close, the priest, deacon, and other ministers approach the altar. The proper reverence to the altar is a profound bow. A profound bow is defined as a "bending at the waist" not just a head bow. For those our servers who are carrying holy items such as the processional cross and the candles, they are to make a head bow. We do not "dip" the cross of Christ nor do we try to pour wax on our floor by dipping the candles.

Also, with the Real Presence of Christ in the tabernacle we ought to genuflect to the presence of Christ in this holy sacrament.

Upon ascending the altar, the priest and deacon, as an expression of veneration, kiss the altar itself. The use of incense is also an option at this point to incense both the altar and the cross.

We live in the shadow of the cross which wrought our salvation and we call upon the name of the One who saves us. So, we sign ourselves with the cross and call upon our God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Second Vatican Council defines us as "... a people brought into unity by the unity of the Trinity." The greeting is never to be "good morning" or some other secular greeting. The greeting signifies the presence of the Lord to the assembled community. The General Instruction to the Roman Missal describes it thus, "By this greeting and the people's response, the mystery of the Church gathered together is made manifest."

After the greeting, the priest or deacon is given some leeway in the General Instruction to introduce the Mass of the Day in some way. We will pick up with the Penitential Rite next week.

I do want to give you all a "heads up" for the coming month... We will have a Mass Saturday morning, 28 September, to celebrate our Titular Feast of St. Wenceslaus. We will have Mass at 8:00 am before the start of the School Marathon. Also, on the following week, we are receiving the Pilgrimage Statue of Our Lady of Fatima. This will be on the First Friday and First Saturday of October. We are planning 24 hours of Adoration and closing with Benediction and Mass. More to come on both events.
