ADOPT-A-FAMILY FOR CHRISTMAS PROGRAM ~ Le Sueur County

For over twenty-five years, this program has operated through St. Wenceslaus Parish with assistance from other churches in New Prague, Montgomery, Le Center, Le Sueur, Cleveland, Henderson, and Kasota. In October, forms were sent out from the county and parents filled them out listing their children's ages (0-12) and **clothing and outerwear gift choices**. The forms are numbered and names are removed to respect the privacy of the families. Families, individuals, or groups choose a child or family to shop for. The gifts will be distributed to the families on Sat., Dec. 14th at five locations in the county. There are many opportunities to participate to make Christmas brighter for a family.

1. Choose a specific family to shop for clothing and outerwear gift items.
2. Donate cash. Our team of Super Shoppers will purchase the gifts. Please make checks payable to Adopt-A-Family.
3. Donate toys, books, games, or other non-clothing items that are appropriate for ages 0-18.

These items will be distributed through the Le Sueur County Santa Anonymous Program. Parents then have the opportunity to pick out non-clothing gifts suitable for their own children (ages 0-18) and clothing items for teens (ages 13-18).
