From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**Padre's Pen –****The Immaculate Conception**

As we celebrate the Second Sunday of Advent, we note the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception also falls on Sunday the 8th this year. Our liturgical celebration remains the 2nd Sunday of Advent.

So, what are we to do when 2 high feast days occur on the same day? In the very front of the Roman Missal (the book that I use on the altar for all the prayers) is a "Table of Liturgical Days" that outlines the various celebrations and their order of precedence in the Church's liturgical life. For example, the number one liturgical celebration in the Church is listed as "The Paschal Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of Our Lord." Then (in order) the Nativity of the Lord, the Epiphany, the Ascension, and Pentecost, followed next by Sundays of Advent, Lent, and Easter. Then we move to weekdays of Holy Week from Monday to Thursday and Days within the Octave of Easter.

Only after those days listed do we get to Solemn Feasts in the General Calendar and this is where the Solemn Feast of the Immaculate Conception falls. Therefore, the Sundays of Advent will always take precedence. Nevertheless, the Immaculate Conception is such an important feast that its celebration is moved to the nearest day following the Sunday, but its obligatory character does not transfer. This is why we are only celebrating one Mass on Monday the 9th for the Solemnity.

The fact that the day is moved should prompt us to reflect on why this Solemnity is considered so important. Some food for thought on that subject: Mary too needs Jesus Christ as her Savior because she is fully human and part of the human race. So, in this particular grace of being preserved from the stain of original sin from the moment of her conception, she receives in a singular and unique way the grace of Jesus Christ's sacrifice on the cross. Thus, being preserved from that stain, she can provide for Jesus her son an Immaculate Body from which He receives His Immaculate and Pure body. And if you could create your own mother perfect, wouldn't you do it just like Jesus did?

Mary... she was good enough for Jesus. She is good enough for me.

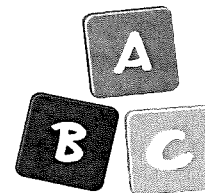
Kindergarten Registration for Fall is Open

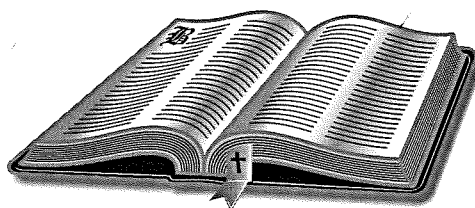

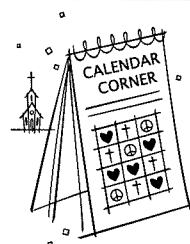
