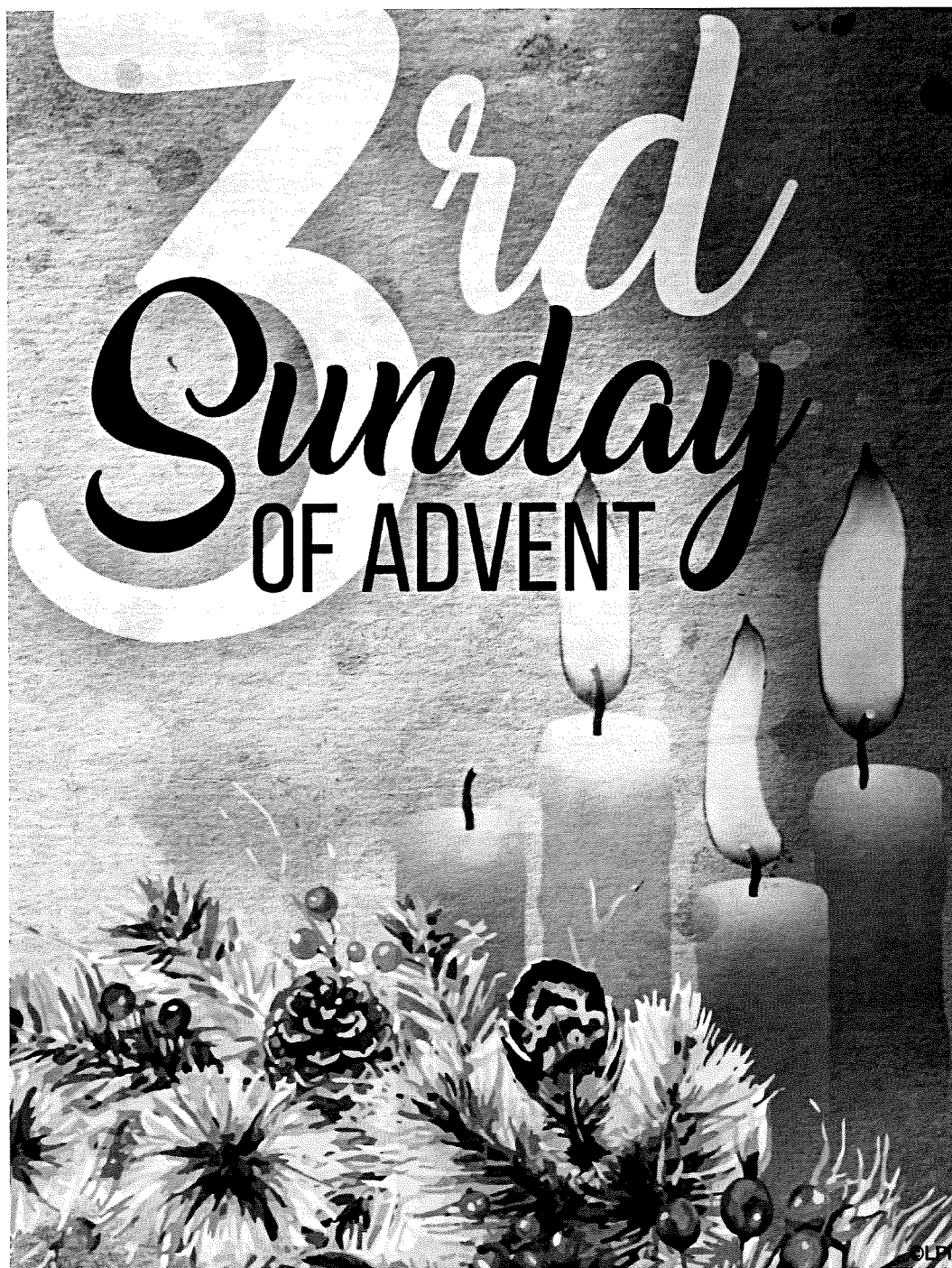

From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**Padre's Pen –
Gaudete Sunday**

My mother and father were married in September of 1958. They bought a home in St. Paul to prepare for their future life and family. Shortly after the wedding mom and dad began preparing for their new family. They were expecting their first child, my oldest sister, Sharon.

For a young couple just starting out with a mortgage and a new construction business, the announcement of the pregnancy brought great joy, but it cost, as well, and strained their budget. They had to pay for the extra doctor visits. Dad prepared the extra room in the house with a bit of self-help remodeling. That was a bit more money. There were diapers and clothing and bottles to purchase. They had to purchase a crib.

Sharon was born on 12 September 1959, the first anniversary of my parents' Marriage. They had to pay for the hospital bills for mom and Sharon's stay (I believe it was 2 weeks back then). Extra milk was delivered to our door for the little girl (yes, back in the day when they still delivered milk in glass bottles). New clothes and new jumpers were purchased. When the cloth diapers wore out, they had to buy more. Sharon outgrew her clothes and by her first birthday they were buying new clothes. There were doctor visits and immunizations; more money. Baby food in the little Gerber jars; more money.

By the time she was 2 years old she was a precocious little girl. I still have her 2-year-old picture on my dresser at the home place with her pretty brown dress with white trim and loafer shoes. More money and more expected with my brother now on the way. The Theisen dynasty was started.

Sharon was diagnosed with leukemia and died quickly on 5 September 1962 just short of her third birthday. Mom and dad had to pay for a casket and a funeral, and they haven't had to spend a dime on her since.

A living Church, like a living child, costs money. I never knew my oldest sister beyond that picture I keep of her and the memories that mom and dad shared over the years. Our Church is a gift that we hold in stewardship for our children and grandchildren. We pray that she isn't just a memory that we talk about and remember with a bit of nostalgia. Let's keep her and her mission (which is the mission of salvation wrought for us in Christ Jesus) at the forefront of our lives.

Novena Prayer in Honor of St. John the Evangelist

Two days after Christmas, on December 27, the Roman Catholic Church celebrates the feast day of St. John the Evangelist, the "Beloved" Apostle of Our Lord. In preparation for this special feast day, let us join together in recitation of the following novena prayer to St. John, Apostle and Evangelist, as originally promulgated by Pope Leo XIII. The novena begins on Dec. 19th and ends on his feast day, Dec. 27th.

"O glorious Apostle, who, on account of thy virginal purity, wast so beloved by Jesus as to deserve to lay thy head upon His divine breast, and to be left, in His place, as son to His most holy Mother: I beg thee to inflame me with a most ardent love toward Jesus and Mary. Obtain for me from Our Lord that I, too, with a heart purified from earthly afflictions, may be made worthy to be ever united to Jesus as a faithful disciple, and to Mary as a devoted son, both here on earth and eternally in heaven. Amen.

Also, important to note, on this patronal feast day, a plenary indulgence may be granted by visiting St. John the Evangelist Church, Union Hill. Note that all plenary indulgences require sacramental confession, Holy Communion, prayers for the intentions of our holy father, Pope Francis, and the absence of any attachment to sin, whether mortal or venial.

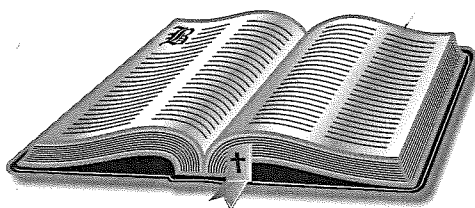

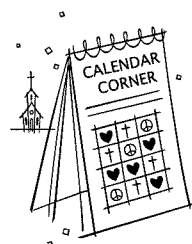
