

Oberammergau Pilgrimage

As we noted last summer, I will be leading a pilgrimage to view the Passion Play in Oberammergau, Germany this summer in July. We will also be visiting Munich, Vienna, Budapest, and Prague. This is called the "Splendors of Eastern Europe" tour. We have 15 people signed up for the pilgrimage. There is still room for a few more people.

For those who do not know, the Passion Play in Oberammergau is performed only every 10 years to keep a 387-year-old promise to our Lord by the people of the town. The whole town participates. There are still Category 3 tickets for the play available to us. I will offer Mass every day on the trip.

Departure from Minneapolis is July 16 and we return on the 26th of July. The cost is about \$4,500 to include round trip airfare, two persons per room with private bath, breakfasts and some dinners, and tickets to the Passion Play and other amenities.

We have information packs available in the main office. If anyone has an interest in joining us, please contact the office and we can get you the packet. The opportunity will close in the next couple weeks, so if you have an interest please let us know soon.

meals served at the Dorothy Day Center in St. Paul. There will be three different soups, various breads, and desserts. We hope you will be able to join us for your evening meal.

Did you know...

that many from NPACC helped prepare and serve nearly 2,500 meals in 2019? Using facilities that we knew as the Dorothy Day Center in St. Paul, these meals are available to anyone. Generally, many are homeless or are marginally employed and a food budget doesn't exist. Simply, money they have is used for rent, utilities, or transportation. Whatever their reason is, we have been able to provide this hot meal with your support.

On October 29, 2019, Catholic Charities Twin Cities opened what was known as Phase II of a \$60 million project. In the completion of this Two Phase project, the community ends up with combined 644 units available for various housing needs. Along with this housing, Catholic Charities Twin Cities offers job training, physical and mental health clinics, a Veterans Resource Hub and housing and placement services.

The Phase I project (\$40 million) completed January 2017

The Phase II (\$60 million) project completed October 2019 is known as the St. Paul Opportunity Center with mixed use to include meal preparation and serving along with housing and client services. These two projects (buildings) are called Dorothy Day Place. Dorothy Day Place is across the street from the Excel Center in St. Paul.
