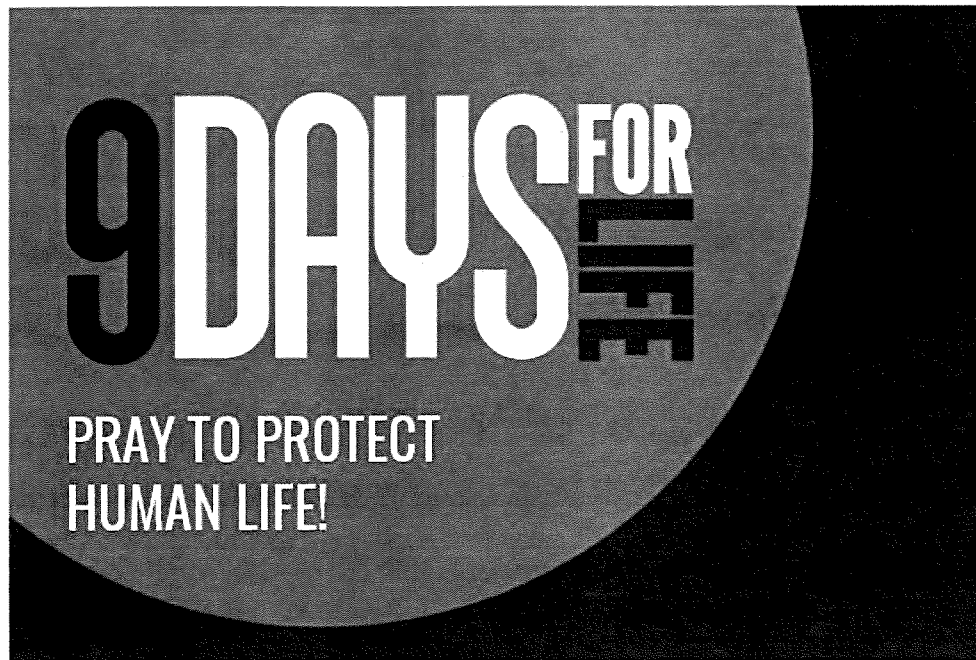

This week marks the 47th anniversary of the Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade decision that legalized abortion at any stage in pregnancy and for any reason. It was and is a thoroughly evil decision that has spawned a whole money-making industry at the expense of human life. If anyone should doubt this, please watch or read the book, "Unplanned." It is the story of a former director of a planned parenthood clinic that provided abortions. Many thanks to our Knights of Columbus Auxiliary for giving us the opportunity to watch it last weekend in our parish. The slippery slope of abortion has now brought us to the point in our country where some states are even passing laws to allow infanticide after the birth of an "unwanted" child.

Our Declaration of Independence lays it out succinctly and names these "unalienable rights... LIFE {emphasis added}, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness." Our faith teaches us that we are knit together in our mother's wombs and are known by God from the very moment of conception (Mary is the Immaculate Conception). The shedding of innocent blood is one of the sins that cry out to heaven per the sacred scriptures (Abel's blood cried out to heaven).

This Wednesday is the National Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. Wednesday's Mass will be offered for this intention. Please pray as you are able and offer some small sacrifice in reparation for this particular sin. When those of us who are experiencing this first "unalienable right" cry out to heaven on behalf of those who are being denied this "unalienable right" we can change our culture and our world.

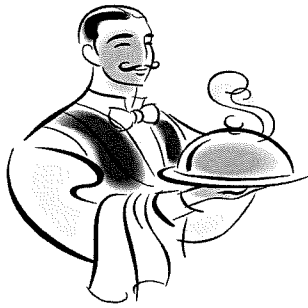

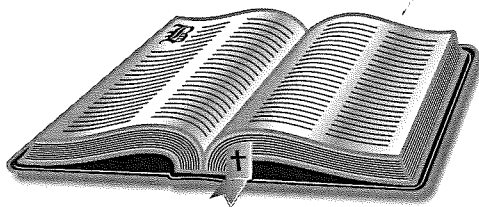

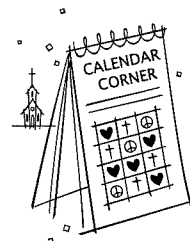
