Some questions came up individually after our Q & A opportunities after Mass 3 weeks ago, so I want to address some of those concerns:

1. What happens if any one church in our parish doesn't meet its goal? Can money be taken from the other churches that surpass their goal and make up the difference? Checking the box for a specific site on the Capital Campaign card is a designation that puts a restriction on that gift. The funds are absolutely designated for that site and, by Minnesota law, the gift must be used for the site that the donor designates. Any surplus at any individual site remains at that site for future capital needs at that site.

2. How do we ensure that the funds donated for a site don't get distributed/used by another site? Separate Capital Campaign savings accounts have been set up and are already in use by each church site in our parish. Monies are disbursed for invoiced costs associated with each individual site.

3. Why are all 3 church sites in our parish lumped into one capital campaign? All 3 sites needed a capital campaign for repairs/upgrades/debt reduction/etc. By combining into one campaign, we lowered the expenses that each would have incurred had we done them separately... we saved money and time for everyone and we put together a great team of individuals from our different sites to work together as one parish ought.

4. What about cost overruns on estimates? Because we don't intend to accrue any debt at any of our three sites, we won't start work until funds are available and we will build in a reasonable percentage for cost overruns based on estimates for individual projects. For example, if the estimate for new boilers at St. Wenceslaus is \$300,000, we will look to industry standards for possible overruns and begin work when we have those funds available.

And for all our parishioners' information, we are currently putting together a Maintenance/Project Committee from and for the St. John and St. Scholastica sites. They will work closely with me, our trustees, and our business administrator in prioritizing the needed projects and maintenance for those sites, plan/implement self-help projects, obtain bids/estimates for projects/needs beyond the scope of self-help, and develop the long-range maintenance and facility goals for those sites.

I thank all our parishioners for their on-going prayers and support to help grow our parish and make Jesus Christ known and loved.

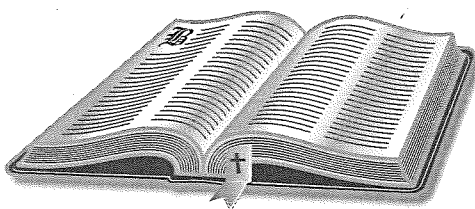

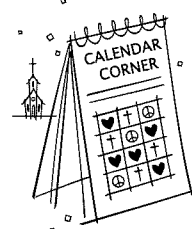
