From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**Padre's Pen –
The Holy Eucharist**

With the latest polls telling us that there is a lack of belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist we can take a look back to the prophetic words of St. John Paul II in his 1980 Letter to all the bishops of the world, "On The Mystery and Worship of the Eucharist."

This must always be remembered, perhaps above all in our time, when we see a tendency to do away with the distinction between the "sacred" and "profane," given the widespread tendency, at least in some places to desecralize everything. In view of this fact, the Church has a special duty to safeguard and strengthen the sacredness of the Eucharist. In our pluralistic and often deliberately secularized society, the living faith of the Christian community—a faith always aware of its rights vis-à-vis those who do not share that faith—ensures respect for this sacredness.

The Holy Eucharist is the source of our life, unity, and being as Catholics. It is also the source of that same life, unity, and being. In our particular case, it is the center of supernatural life sitting in the middle of New Prague, Union Hill, and Heidelberg. It is not out of style to genuflect when we come into our church, to keep a respectful silence before the awesome mystery both before and after Mass, to make the sign of the cross every time we pass the church.

The more we keep a sense of the sacred around this most gracious gift of God Himself, the more the respect, honor, and glory due to Him will get passed on to the next generations and spill over into our culture.

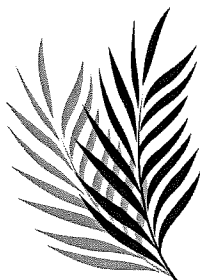

Dear Parishioners,

After much prayer and discernment, I presented Fr. Eugene Theisen with my letter of resignation bringing my time serving this parish to an end. At the beginning of March, I will be taking the position of Director of Operations at St. Peter's Church in Mendota. While I am looking forward to different challenges the new position will bring, it is hard to say goodbye to the New Prague Area Catholic Community. My time here has been a blessing to me and my family. I began my work here in August 2004 and, having been hired by Fr. George Freeman, continuing with Fr. Kevin Clinton and Fr. Eugene.

In my time here I have come to appreciate the unique characteristics of this parish; the strong tradition of support, the wonderful festivals, parishioners that step into leadership roles, and the generosity of the parish. Through the leadership and contributions of many families, the parish has reduced the debt from \$3.9 million in 2004 to \$452,000 today. In addition to this major accomplishment, the parish also repaired the church towers and rebuilt the parking lot. During this time, collections to support all of the wonderful programs and ministries of the community were provided. The parish has some activity on one of its campuses 365 days a year, and sustaining that level of ministry is a testament to the parishioners that make this parish come alive.

I would like to thank the many parishioners (too many to list) that have served on the Parish Finance Council, Parish Pastoral Council, and as trustees and other groups that I have had the privilege to minister with since 2004. Each of you has taught and supported me. My relationship with each of you is indeed one of God's deepest blessings to me. One of the hardest parts leaving this parish is saying goodbye to my colleagues on staff. They are a truly gifted group of people who bring energy, enthusiasm, faith, and a deep love for the people of the parish to their ministries. They are role models for me and I have learned so much from each of them.

Stations of the Cross

For Catholics throughout the world, the Stations of the Cross are synonymous with Lent, Holy Week, and especially, Good Friday. This devotion is also known as the "Way of the Cross," the "Via Crucis," and the "Via Dolorosa." It commemorates 14 key events on the day of Christ's crucifixion. It honors His final walk through the streets of Jerusalem, carrying the Cross. The Stations originated in medieval Europe when wars prevented Christian pilgrims from visiting the Holy Land. European artists created works depicting scenes of Christ's journey to Calvary. The faithful installed these sculptures or paintings at intervals along a procession route, inside the parish church, or outdoors. Performing the devotion meant walking the entire route, stopping to pray at each "station." Don't miss these opportunities for Stations of the Cross this Lent.

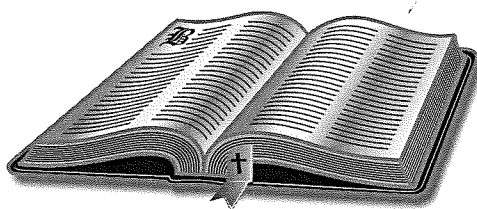

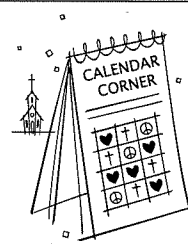
