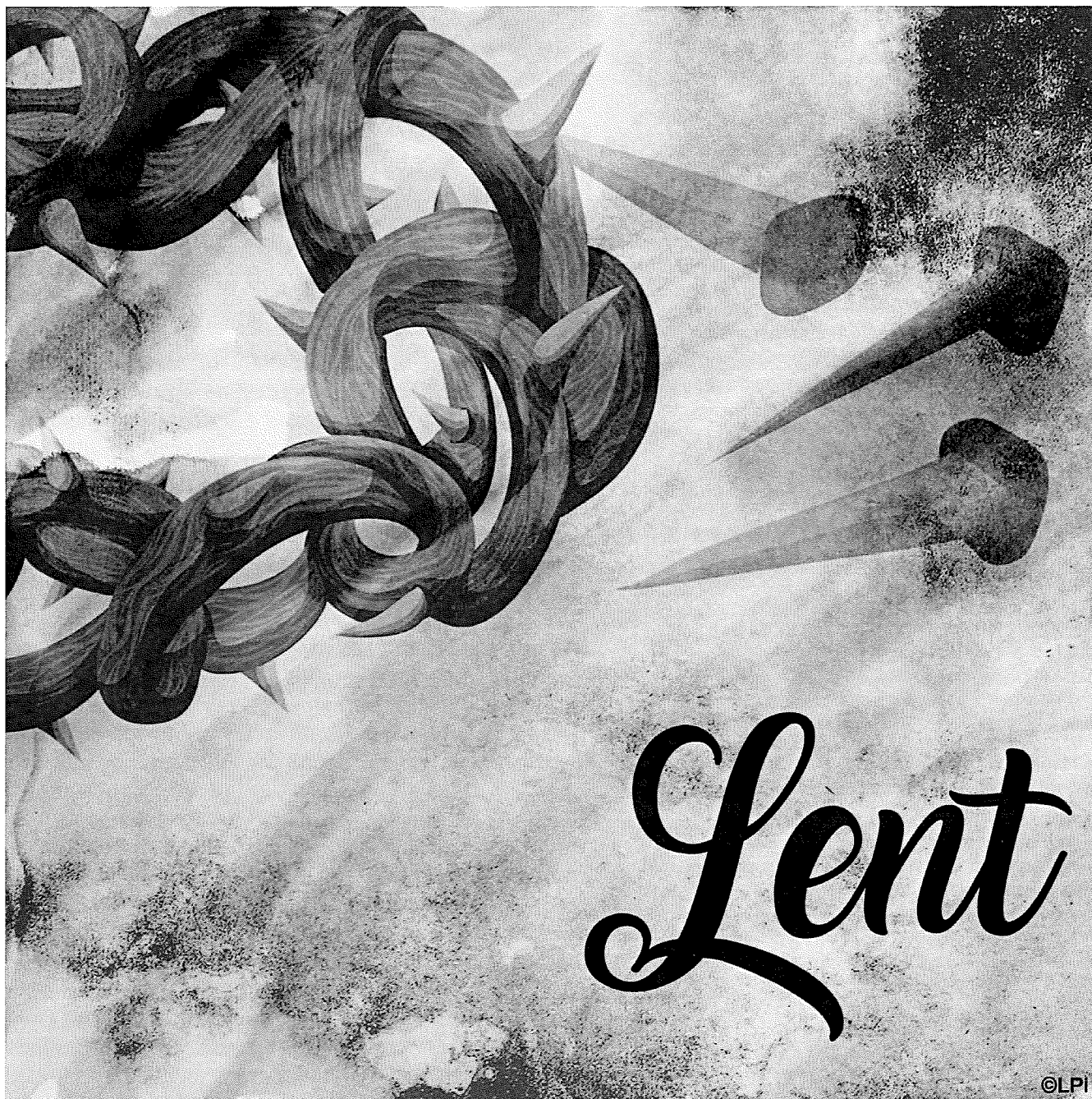

**A Note From Our Pilgrims**

This January, after being nominated and selected, we were granted the amazing opportunity to travel on pilgrimage to Rome along with 22 other Catholic young adults and the bishops from Region VIII ~ Minnesota, North Dakota, and South Dakota.

The Ad Limina Apostolorum visit (translation: "the threshold of the apostles") brought us to the Heart of the Church as we followed in the footsteps of both our local Bishops and the Apostles themselves while taking in the depth and history of our faith. This experience was immensely spiritual and deepened our relationship with Christ and others, including Archbishop Hebda and Bishop Cozzens.

We participated in intimate daily Masses that allowed us to feel the connection to the early Church and see the beauty in the tradition of the Mass and Eucharist. Four of the Masses were held in the major basilicas in Rome, including one in the crypt of St. Peter's Basilica, surrounded by the tombs of former Popes. We were also blessed to attend Sunday Mass at the Pontifical North American College and witness the installation of our region's seminarians as lectors, one step forward in their journey towards priesthood.

A major highlight of the trip was meeting the Holy Father! After a general audience, he spent a few minutes shaking our hands and humbly asked our group: "Pray for me, not against me." This experience sent us on a spiritual high which was only heightened as we continued our day visiting the tombs of St. Peter and St. Paul.

There is something special about being in a city full of consecrated religious, surrounded by beautiful churches filled with relics and tombs of the saints, and touring through a Catholic lens. It was, without a doubt, a life-changing experience that we hope can have an impact on those around us.

We are hosting a young adult book study during Lent focusing on the 99 Handbook on Thursdays at 6:30-8:00, which began on February 27th. Please encourage any young adults that may be interested to join us!
