From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**Padre's Pen –**

I sit here Monday night at 8:30 writing a column where I have more questions than answers. I just spent the day moving my mother to a new facility where she can get the skilled care that she needs, kissed her goodbye not knowing if I will be able to get back in to see her in the next week or two or more since there are so many quarantines (they only let us in today to move her in).

I got back tonight and had a conference call with the Capital Campaign Committee, re-arranged for a marriage that is scheduled for later this month, spoke with our Deanery 7 Dean, and reviewed a fair number of e-mails from my brother priests. Needless to say, things are a bit overwhelming. Nevertheless, I'm not in a combat zone where an enemy is shooting rocket propelled grenades and mortars at me, so the stress level is not near as high as I've seen it in my past. Jesus Christ stood by me then and He is standing with us now!

The wedding couple I spoke with this evening set a great example we can all follow. They called me and proposed that we significantly scale back the wedding plans by keeping what is absolutely most important; the celebration of the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony with just a small number of family members and do the big reception and celebration later when we get through this crisis. What a great example of faith! I told them that we can work with that very easy.

In a similar vein regarding our parish, I will be digging in the next few days with the staff, the finance council, and parish leadership to make some plans about our way forward should our current situation continue for any length of time. We will be looking at what is most essential and must happen/continue and what we can postpone until a more opportune time.

All of us are going to feel a bit of a pinch during this time if we haven't felt it already, whether it be social, emotional, financial, spiritual, etc. We are early in this crisis and we are still in a bit of a reactionary mode. If my experience from the combat zones tells me anything, we will eventually normalize as best we can, given the situation, develop workable solutions, and progress through to a reasonable solution. While we go through this process, we can lean on our Blessed Lord and Our Lady. We can take the opportunity to renew and strengthen the bond of love that was forged on Calvary and come through with a stronger faith in God's presence and control in the midst of the most chaotic of circumstances. God Love you all!

EXAMEN FOR LIFE DURING COVID-19

The Examen is a traditional method of prayerful awareness that is a bedrock in Ignatian spirituality and Jesuit education. It's a short, easy way to reflect on your day and become more mindful about where you are experiencing grace or goodness and where there is room in your actions and life for growth. Especially in times of uncertainty and rapid change, taking time to reflect becomes essential.

What people don't often realize is that the Examen is exceptionally flexible and adaptive. It can be used to review your day, or it can be adapted to home in on a specific issue or focus. So, in light of the new set of circumstances many of us find ourselves in with COVID-19, it is helpful to adapt the Examen to this unique situation.

Take a moment to settle. Take a deep breath. Get comfortable. Like a rock settling on the bottom of a lake after it's thrown in, let yourself settle.

1. Acknowledge how you are feeling in this moment. If being calm is hard, acknowledge it. If you find yourself frustrated or stressed, acknowledge it. God wants to be present in all parts of our lives ~ not just the easy or serene moments.
 2. Ask for light and insight as you prepare to review your day. For some that light may come in the form of a sense of the Divine. For others it's from a deep sense of your true self.
 3. Take a moment to think about how COVID-19 has impacted your life. Even as we are being asked to distance ourselves from one another socially, ask yourself what connections you find yourself grateful for? Who makes you feel grounded and connected to God?
 4. Public health issues have a way of making us recognize how interwoven our lives are with others in society. It can help us realize who we may often choose not to see or connect with.

Is there a person or group of people especially affected by COVID-19 that you don't often choose to see or connect with normally? What connections to others are you becoming more aware of? Who do you normally choose to reach out and connect to? Who do you avoid or refuse to see? If you can, picture the faces of these people. What connections do you take for granted in your life? What connections impact you the most?

5. Note the emotions you feel when you think of these individuals without judging or overanalyzing. Simply acknowledge them, pay attention, and listen to where God may be speaking. As you think of the ways we are connected or disconnected to one another, pick a connection (or lack thereof) that seems important, significant, or is manifesting itself the strongest. Pause and reflect on where you're being invited to grow from that moment. If you are a person of faith, take a moment to pray with it.
6. God gifted us with limitless creativity and imagination. Even in this time of separation and possible isolation, what is one way you can maintain meaningful connection to others ~ whether directly, through technology, or intentional focus and attention?

Take a deep breath and moment of quiet. When you are ready, return to your day.

Thanks to all who took the Synod Disciple Maker Index. I think we had a great response. We had emails for 1,353 households who should have received the survey. Of those, we received 58 back with faulty e-mail addresses for a total of 1295 households receiving the survey (twice). We had 422 people respond. That is a 33% response rate. Thank you to all who took the time to let your voice be heard!

Franciscan Retreats and Spirituality Center

The Covid-19 virus spreads ever more tragically. Public health leaders have offered more definitive guidance. We realize all our communities have a significant role to play in the concerted public health response. The Conventual Franciscan Friars of the Province of Our Lady of Consolation have decided to cancel, postpone, or reschedule retreats, programs, and events at our three retreat centers: **Franciscan Retreats and Spirituality Center in Prior Lake, MN;** Mount Saint Francis ~ Center for Spirituality in Mount St. Francis, IN; and Holy Cross Retreat Center in Las Cruces, NM. 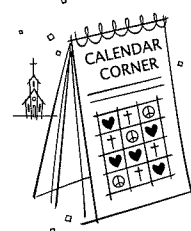
