



## Padre's Pen ~ **Vacations and Missionaries**

As we read through the Gospels and see the life of Jesus revealed to us through them, we see that on many occasions Jesus withdrew

from the crowds and even from His disciples to pray to His Father in heaven. It was a time away ~ to recharge and prepare for important moments in His life.

I will be withdrawing this week on a little vacation to pray and work (manual labor up north with my brother). My Mass kit will be packed. I'll say Mass, pray my daily Liturgy of the Hours, my rosary, and other devotions. In the midst of those prayers, I'll be working on putting a few callouses on my hands. I will be staying at a very rustic cabin with no plumbing or amenities (if we want electricity, we have to bring our generator). As part of my sabbatical after retiring from the Air Force, I spent a couple months just laboring around the home place. I worked and prayed in the solitude and quiet of the country. It gave me a great sense of peace and it let me release much of the tension accumulated during years of military service.

I'm hopeful that a few days up north will refresh and renew me from the past several months of responding to the COVID-19 pandemic. It's a few days away to prepare for the important work ahead of us to open our school, re-start our Faith Formation programs, continue in the celebration of the sacraments, sustain our Church and operations for future generations through our Capital Campaign, and proclaim the Kingdom of God in our midst.

Upon my return we will have a guest speaker for all our Liturgies in cooperation with the Archdiocesan Missionary Cooperation Plan. Ms. Diane Yonga, a parishioner of the Cathedral of St. Paul and lay missionary with the Lay Mission Helpers Association based in Los Angeles, California, will be here to speak to us. She has a mission to the Diocese of Damongo in northern Ghana. She will bring greetings from their Bishop, Peter Paul Angkyier, and make the annual mission appeal on his behalf.

I look forward to greeting this year's missionary and returning refreshed and renewed with you next week.

### MaryCarol's Social Justice Project-Update

Due to the Coronavirus, we have not been able to use our reusable cloth bags. Are you accumulating a whole lot of plastic grocery bags at your house? Did you know that it takes about 700 grocery bags turned into PLARN to make one 6 ft. by 3 ft. mat? These mats can be rolled up and come with a carrying strap. It is lightweight and easy to carry. They work as an insulating layer from the ground protecting from the cold and possible hypothermia. These mats are easy to clean and don't attract bedbugs or lice. Let's keep them out of our landfills and put them to good use to make sturdy crocheted mats for the homeless. We begin by gathering plastic grocery bags; you can drop them off or pick some up in the blue barrel by the elevator door at St. Wenceslaus. 

### Minsistry & Social Justice Corner: Our common home ~ for the common good.

We have it good. Most of us have air conditioning to help us make it through the hot spells that we've recently experienced. We have a ready source of food and enough water for drinking, recreation, lawn and gardens. Not everyone in the world can say the same; Pope Francis challenges us not to turn away in indifference.

The worst impact of climate change will be felt by developing countries in coming decades. Pope Francis tells us

in Laudato Si: "Many of the poor live in areas particularly affected by warming, and their means of subsistence are largely dependent on natural reserves and agriculture, fishing and forestry. They have no other financial activities or resources which can enable them to adapt to climate change or to face natural disasters, and their access to social services and protection is very limited." (25) The Pope challenges us who live in developed nations to take seriously our responsibility to care about our brothers and sisters.

We have choices. We can make sure that our elected officials take action to reduce fossil fuel usage and increase use of renewable energy sources. Business and industry can look for ways to reduce energy use by being more efficient and continuing work on technologies that help the cause. Working from home has become common for some workers during the pandemic, with a consequent

reduction in energy consumption and emissions. Companies can re-examine what a work force and workspace look like. There are small things we all can do that add up to change that matters.
