



### From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen



### <u>Padre's Pen</u> ~ Patriotic Rosary, Tractor Blessings, and Holy Communion

We just celebrated on September 8 the Birth of the Virgin Mary and on the 15th we will celebrate the Octave Day of that same celebration; the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. The paradox of celebrating the Joy of Our Lady's birth and the bitter sorrows she suffered as a result of being the perfect mother of our Savior tells us that Joy and Sorrow are two sides of the same coin.

Similarly we live in a country while founded on great principles of freedom and equality, there is also the flip side of the coin where there have been bitter struggles and sorrows as we continue to work to keep our freedoms and equality before the law and as values in our country. We have had a Civil War over this, the demonstrations and upheavals of the '60s and '70s, and are currently under another great upheaval with demonstrations, violence, looting, abuses, etc. More than ever we need to be on our knees in prayer!

We just started our 54-Day Rosary Novena for the soul of our country. This Sunday evening, we will be praying the Patriotic Rosary at St. John's in Union Hill. In this rosary we pray for our country, our President and Governors and their staffs, our Senate, House, and Judiciary on Federal and State levels, and we pray for our families. Please join us at St. John's ~ or ~ if you are not able to join us in person, pray an extra rosary at 6:00 pm for our country, her leaders, our states and their leaders, and for our families.

We are entering harvest season and I am again offering Tractor Blessings for your machinery and prayers for a good harvest (and good prices for that harvest). The blessings will be after the 5:00 pm Saturday Mass at St. Wenceslaus, the 8:15 pm Mass at St. John, the 8:00 am Mass at St. Scholastica, and the 10:00 am Mass at St. John. Park your tractors outside our churches and I will come out after the Final Blessing for the Blessing.

The Archdiocese has changed COVID protocols and now allows us to distribute Holy Communion at the proper time during Mass. Beginning next weekend, 19th & 20th of September, all our Masses will return to distribution of Holy Communion at the proper time in Mass. All other protocols remain the same including capacity restrictions and mask wearing.


