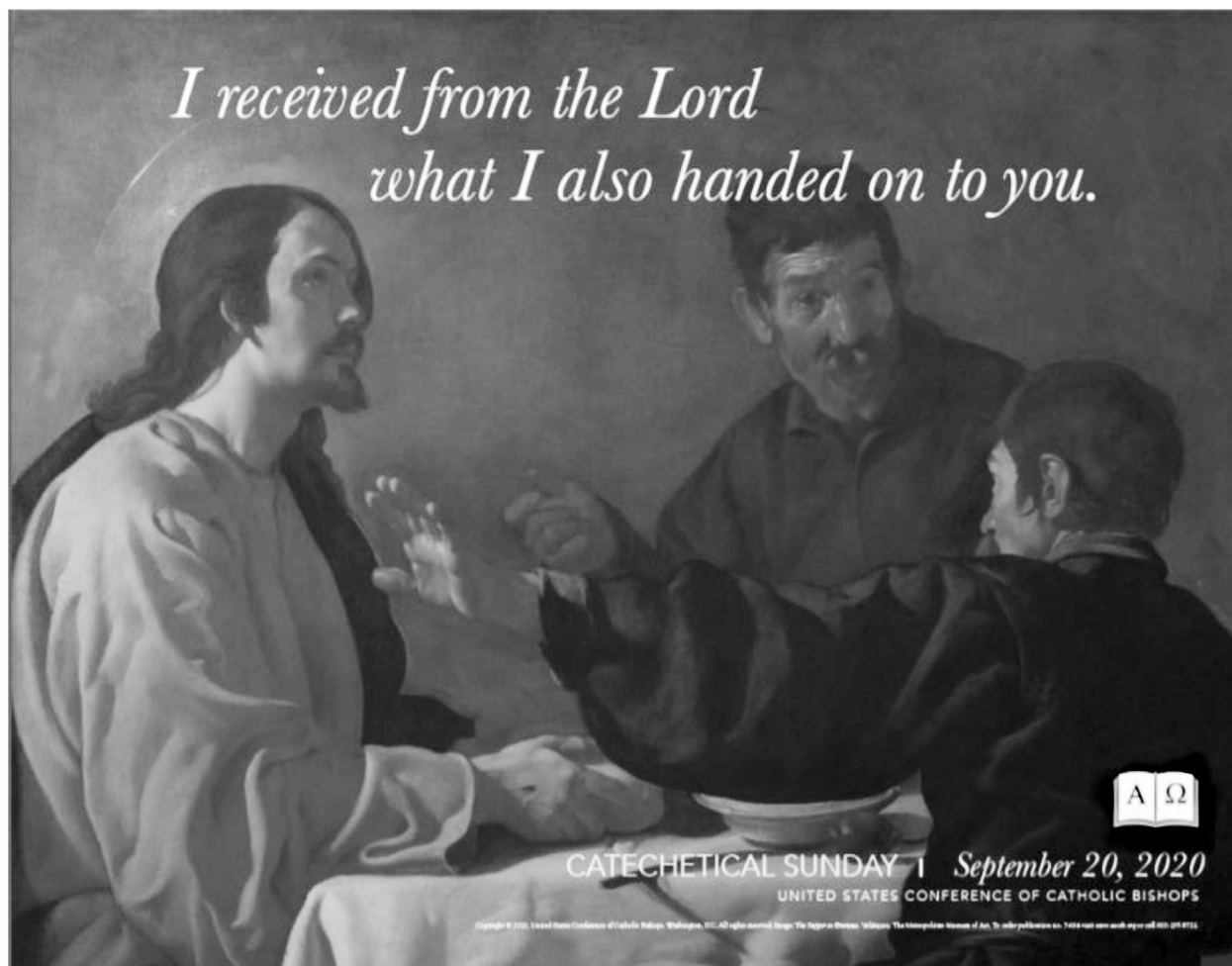

**From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**

**Padre's Pen ~  
School & R.E. Masses,  
St. Wenceslaus Feast  
and the Marathon**

This Wednesday, 23 September, we will have our opening All School Mass and our opening Faith Formation Mass. We look forward to incorporating our young people into the source and summit of our Catholic Christian life; the celebration of Holy Mass. Because of COVID-19 we ask the following for these Masses:

1. For the All School Mass at 8:00 AM, ***we ask that our regular Mass attendees, parents, and grandparents skip this first All School Mass.*** We are working out our plan for seating and maintaining proper protocols. We know there will be some extra seats, but we are working on the best format for seating to accommodate as many as possible. We ask that our parishioners give our teachers and students this first opportunity to "work the bugs out."
2. Please note we have this issue because God has answered our prayers. We have prayed constantly and insistently that God would bless us with increased enrollment in our school. We have 173 in our K-8 programs and are over 210 total, including our preschool. This is a great blessing and we thank God for answering our prayers.
3. For our opening Mass for Faith Formation at 6:30 PM, we do invite parents to join your children for the evening Mass. Our preliminary numbers are showing we can make this work.

I am very grateful for the uptick in attendance at all our Masses. We have been doing some rearranging in the church itself, so from now on our ropes will be covering every other pew so families won't have to separate for the celebration of Mass. I do ask that if you are coming to Mass alone to try sitting in a pew with another person attending alone but on opposite ends of the pew. This will alleviate some of the seating issues I've seen the past couple of weeks.

Also, our Patronal Feast Day is coming up on September 28. The Feast of St. Wenceslaus coincides with our School Marathon as well. We will have an All School Mass that morning at 8:00 am and an All Parish Mass at 5:00 pm. I will expose the Blessed Sacrament in the main church at the end of 8:00 am Mass for all day adoration. One Lap of my marathon will be in procession with the Blessed Sacrament around our School and Church. This will be at Noon. All are invited to walk in this procession with me keeping the proper distances. Benediction will be at 5:00 pm and the Mass immediately following. Debbie is working hard on a Mass that will highlight our newly repaired organ.

Finally, I will be doing an additional 9 laps around our church and school during the day with Ron McBroom. I welcome your support to our school and to hopefully someday help me raise more for our youth than Ron does☺

## Catechetical Sunday

**September 20, 2020**

This Sunday is Catechetical Sunday, traditionally the way we acknowledge and appreciate those men and women who have stepped up to help catechize our children in the faith. This year, we have a bigger than ever batch of catechists ~ our parents!

At St. Wenceslaus, we have always acknowledged that the family "is our first community and the most basic way in which the Lord gathers us, forms us, and acts in the world" (Follow the Way of Love). That is why we are confident that our parents are up to the challenge of passing on the faith to their children in a bigger way this year. We will sorely miss having our 1-7 grade youth on campus. We are still here to supply, accompany, support, pray for, mentor, and assist our families as they pass on our Catholic faith to their children.

We look to this as an opportunity for families (whatever that may look like for you) to grow in their faith and love of Jesus together. As the old adage goes, the family that prays together, stays together. I believe God will use this time for His good.

Research shows that children will develop their identity and worldview NOT by weighing all the intellectual information thrown at them, BUT by adopting the views of those who leave the deepest impression on them, those who love and care for them the most – namely their parents.

Many parents may feel unequipped to take on this role. But they shouldn't ... Parents don't need theology degrees or be a Bible scholar to pass on their faith. Parents already have what they need to form their children in the faith and introduce them to a relationship with Jesus ... their love for them and their desire for what is best for their children. Plus, we have a God who has sent the Holy Spirit to guide and help us. He won't leave us stranded. Ask Him for that help.

As a parish community, we are all called to be Disciples. One way we do this is through the way we live our lives. As parents, grandparents, neighbors and friends ... we can all jump in to help through actions, prayers, words and deeds.

God bless our families in a special way as they continue to "be the good".

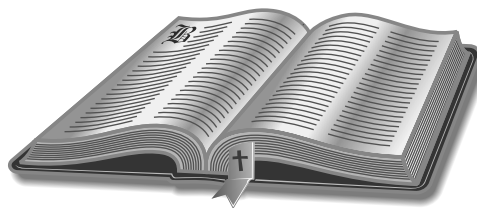

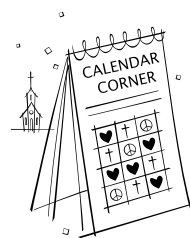
