



### ... Looking forward to tax time?

Have you lost the ability to deduct your contributions since the new tax laws have increased the standard deduction? QCDs, IRAs, RMDs and DAFs may be a possibility for you!

- 1. QCD's Qualified Charitable Distributions. Owners of IRAs who are at least age 70% can contribute some or all of their IRAs to charity. An IRA has a RMD  $\sim$  (required minimum distribution) after you turn 70%  $\sim$  this amount is taxed as ordinary income, UNLESS you process the distribution as a QCD!
- 2. DAF's Donor Advised Funds. You may be able to deposit current and future contributions into a DAF. "The amount deposited may be over the threshold that would allow you to itemize the total this current year; while holding the funds in the sponsored DAF for future contributions.

Adopt a Family for Christmas will be operated through the New Prague Area Catholic Community again this year, but some changes will be made because of Covid-19. We also anticipate greater need.

As in the past, forms are sent out from county Department of Human Services around the middle of October. Parents fill out the forms listing their children's ages and sizes of clothing and outerwear gift choices. This year, parents will also be making two clothing choices for teens.

The forms are then forwarded from the county to our St. Wenceslaus YAC group where they are numbered; names are removed to respect families' privacy. Families, individuals, or groups then choose a child or family to shop for. Gifts will be distributed to the families on Monday, December 14 in Le Center along with Santa Anonymous gifts. Le Sueur County Santa Anonymous program provides toys, books, games, and other non-clothing items.

There are two opportunities to make Christmas brighter for these families.

1. Choose a family and shop for clothing items.
