**From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen****Padre's Pen ~****Christ the King**

It's great to be back with you after a very restful (but busy vacation). THANK YOU! to everyone who turned out and helped clean our churches during this little break. The churches look great and my nose could tell something different than the cleaners we've been using for so long.

As we have almost completed our election season (as it works its way through courts and run-off elections begin in some areas), we are reminded this weekend as to who is really in charge. We celebrate the Solemnity of Jesus Christ King of the Universe this weekend. Jesus Christ alone can heal the brokenness and division that has so marked our country in the runup to the election and beyond. We live in this world but are not of this world. We are created by God and for God. We are called to prepare in this life for an eternity that transcends the politics of this world. None of us can escape the eventuality of meeting the King of Kings and Lord of Lords when our lives have run their course. 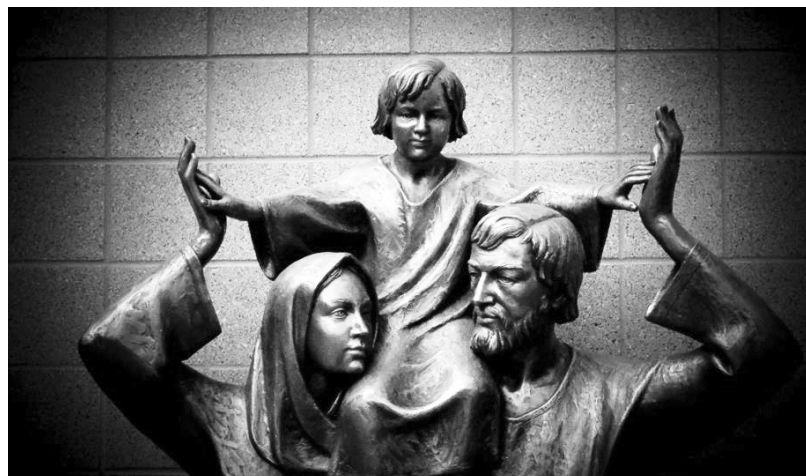
**Advent Opportunity!****Rejoice!****Advent Opportunities**

**Pay attention to your king!** I can't remember when I learned how to play chess. I wonder if children today are learning the game. To them, chess must seem incredibly quaint, old-fashioned, and slow. It uses a whole different set of skills, relying on thinking ahead and getting into your opponent's thoughts rather than hand-eye coordination.

An interesting component to chess is the relative weakness of the king compared with the other chess pieces around him. The king must be protected at all costs even as the other pieces move to attack the opposing king. This is an interesting concept of kingship.

On this Feast of Christ the King, we have an image of the Shepherd protecting the sheep. It is a comforting and familiar image. We know that God protects us. But the readings also challenge us to protect one another—the weak, the hungry, the imprisoned.



This reflects the kingship of Jesus. We are being trusted to make Christ's kingship what it needs to be. We become the presence of Christ our king in the world today. We determine the image of Christ for the world to see and experience as Christ works through us—if we let him. It is our choice. And how we respond determines if we have protected Christ's presence in our world.

This is no easy task. To be able to make all the right

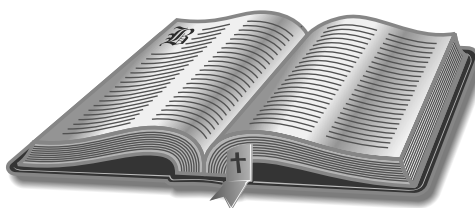

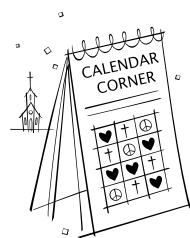
