From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**Padre's Pen ~
1st Sunday in Advent**

When I came home for my annual vacation in 2014 in the first week of November for deer hunting and to help my parents with the leaves and yard work, my father was already terminally ill (though we did not yet know it). I could tell something was seriously wrong but still went off for deer opener Saturday morning. I think I lasted a half a day and headed for home to have Mass with my parents and start on the yard work. The fact that my dad was not in the yard told me something was really wrong. He was not a man to sit back when there was some work to be done.

As I drove the tractor around the yard with the leaf-vac behind I could see my father "supervising" from the various windows of the house (he even saw me run into one of the trees, but he didn't say a word). It is one of the fondest last memories I have of my father. Though he could not be in the yard working with me, he was doing it vicariously through me. We have a big yard and it took me a few days to do all the things that dad normally did. He thanked me for taking care of business on my vacation.

I sat Saturday evening in the rectory kitchen looking out the window seeing our good parishioners come for the evening Mass (most probably not knowing that we would have Archbishop Hebda as my replacement while I quarantine). The experience very much reminded me of my father. There was work to be done, but I couldn't do it. For the first time I sat at my computer and watched the St. Wenceslaus Live Stream Mass. I "supervised from the window."

I'm deeply grateful to Archbishop Hebda, Fr. Michael Tix, Fr. George Graftsky, and our very own Fr. Michael Skluzacek who were all here last weekend to ensure the sacraments were made available to the people of God.

The work of the Kingdom of God will always be plentiful and like the leaves around the home place in Hugo, it will always need someone to take care of business. It won't always be the same person unless that person is Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ in me, in you, in our Archbishop, in all those who work in the Kingdom is the continuity that keeps our Church upright and holy. Our mission is to allow Him to work in us while we have that ability then humbly step back when the time comes for other workers in the Kingdom.

In the meantime, I look forward to getting past this quarantine and getting back to business.

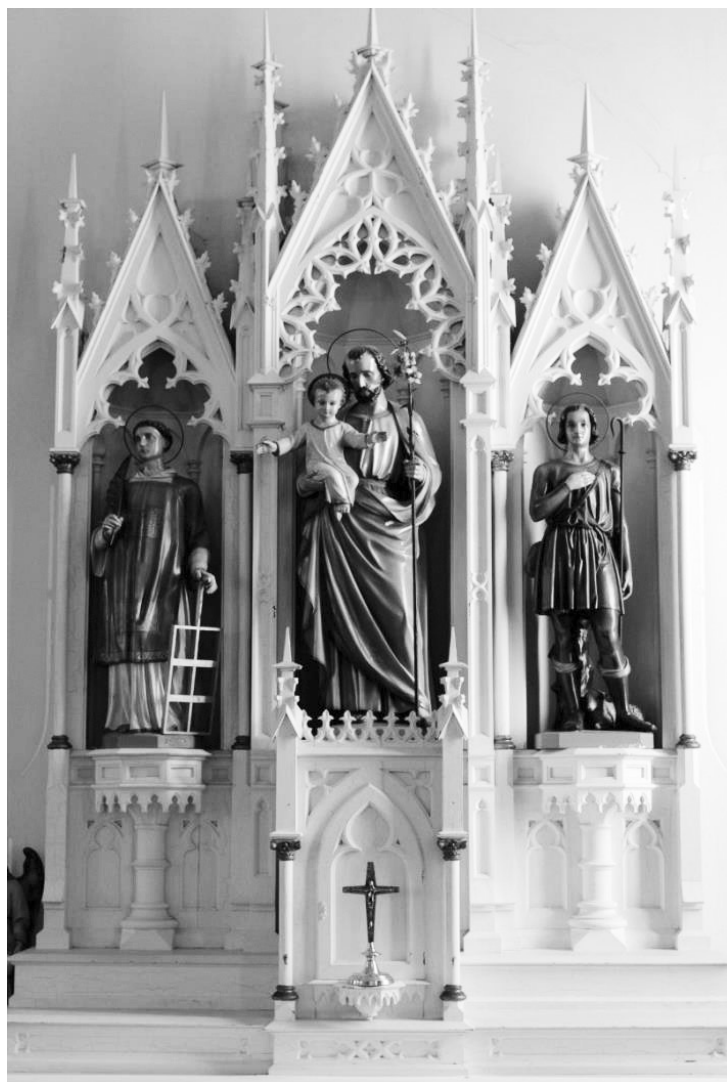

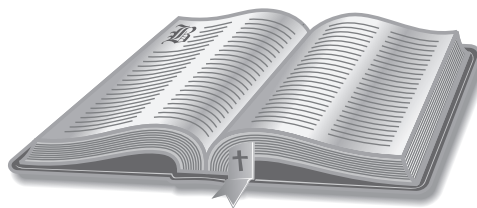
