#### Candlemas, Catholic Schools Week, St. Blaise, Lenten Wednesday Parish Mass, Ushers

Tuesday, February 2nd is Candlemas Day. It is the Feast that commemorates the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple 40 days after his birth. In the words of the holy man Simeon in the temple that day, Jesus is "...a light to reveal you to the nations and the glory of your people Israel." On this feast we both light candles at Mass and we bless candles at Mass. I will have various candles that we use in the liturgy placed in the church and bless them at the beginning of Mass. If any families have candles that they would like blessed at the same time, you may bring them to this Mass and place them on or near the table that I use for the liturgical candles.

We also celebrate Catholic Schools Week this week. It is particularly poignant this year given the extra effort that our Principal, Teachers, Staff, Parents and Families have expended to insure we have the best quality education, in-person, and safe. Everyone has made sacrifices to make this work and God has preserved us by his grace and through those sacrifices from the worst effects and outcomes from the Coronavirus. God has indeed blessed us in so many ways through our efforts, programming, and with increased enrollment. I cannot thank everyone enough for their fidelity to our program and the sacrifices being made!


Wednesday, February 3rd is St. Blaise Day. I will do a brief service at 5:30 pm in St. Wenceslaus Church with the Blessing of Throats to follow. I will offer a general throat blessing over all then use the crossed candles and try my best not to touch anyone with them for each individual blessing (for those who are comfortable coming forward for this).

Starting Ash Wednesday and going for the duration of Lent only, I will be offering a Wednesday daily Mass for the parishioners at 5:30 PM (School Mass remains at 8:00 AM and is closed to the general public). After Lent and Holy Week are over, we will go back to the single daily School Mass at 8:00 AM. When school lets out for the summer, the 8:00 AM Mass will be re-opened to the public.


