
SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

February 14, 2021



The Season of Lent consists of six Sundays and forty weekdays which are designed to prepare us for the high feast of Easter. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends with the beginning of the Mass of the Lord's Supper in the evening on Holy Thursday.

Holy Week is a term that is still used even with the renewal of the Triduum. It refers to the week beginning with Palm (Passion) Sunday and ending with Holy Saturday. It includes the last days of Lent.

The Triduum, the ancient "Great Three Days," celebrate the heart of our Christian Faith. It begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, continues through Good Friday and Holy Saturday, and culminates in the Easter Vigil. The Solemnity of Easter is celebrated not only on Easter Sunday, but on the next seven days as well.

Padre's Pen ~

Be Recollected in the Lord

I pray that as we begin Lent this year that we will all come out the other side in a new resurrection both in the natural and super-

natural sense. I hope that pandemics and COVID may start to be a fading memory and that the image of Christ in each one of us may be an ascending reality. While for the former it will probably be time and herd immunity that starts the fading process, for the latter it is God's grace with our cooperation that will bring us into greater conformity to our Lord and Savior lesus Christ.

Our cooperation with God's grace can be hindered by a multitude of distractions. World, national, and local events can agitate us. People, both friends and foes, can impose on us. Desires, passions, fears, and cares can surround us and send our minds off down a million different rabbit trails. This is what is deemed as the battle of prayer.


Our Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that "Prayer is both a gift of grace and a determined response on our part. It always presupposes effort." Lent is the time where we redouble our efforts and attempt to be more recollected in our life of prayer. It is a season of turning our hearts to our First and Last Love, the Alpha and Omega, to Jesus Christ. With our normal day to day activities, the emergent tasks/needs that always arise, and the interior emotions that assail us, it can be very hard to remain recollected in the presence of Christ.

I suggest that we all start small. Give to our Lord 10 minutes of recollected prayer a day (or whatever brief period you may choose). That means to drop everything and say, "Lord you have these next 10 minutes." Don't think about the mortgage, the bills, or the latest deadline. Don't ask for anything. Don't expect anything. Literally, just waste time for Christ (don't fall asleep either though you would be in good company with Peter, James, and John). Say with Samuel from the Bible, "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening."

Do this for Lent and see what the Lord will do for you. I recommend that every able adult choose at least one penance from each of the areas of Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving and that you can go as high as three in each area in so far as the Spirit leads you. Do not be afraid. I have found over the years that once we get started in Lent with our penances, we find out how easy it can be. God gives us the grace needed to persevere and to do so joyfully.


