From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**Padre's Pen ~ Adoration to End Abortion and St. John Christmas Pageant**

On Wednesday, December 1st (this week) the United States Supreme Court is hearing oral arguments in a case that could significantly help the Pro-Life cause. The case regards a Mississippi law that limits abortions after 15 weeks and is called *Dobbs vs. Jackson Women's Health*. We are joining a nation-wide prayer effort called Adoration to Defeat Abortion. To that end, we are adding to the schedule at St. John in Union Hill this Wednesday:

- 4:00 pm – Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- 4:00 – 5:30 pm Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament to defeat abortion
- 5:00 pm Latin Rosary (aids/pamphlets available to assist) for Our Blessed Mother's intercession to end abortion
- 5:30 pm – Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament
- 5:35 pm – Mass

All are invited to join us in prayer that God will restore in the laws of our country protection for the innocent children in the womb.

The Church of St. John in Union Hill will be preparing for and presenting a Christmas Pageant as they have done for so many years. Ted and Paige Nytes will be directing the program this year. They are looking for children/young people to participate and anyone who wants to help. The Christmas Pageant will be Wednesday, December 15 at 5:30 pm followed by our rosary and Mass (i.e., our regular 5:30 pm Mass moved to approximately 6:30 pm). - Nevertheless, the Stichas love adventure (zip-lining and mountain skiing), sports (softball & baseball), and coffee (iced & black)




