

<u>Padre's Pen</u> ~ Adoration to End Abortion and St. John Christmtas Pageant

On Wednesday, December 1st (this week) the United States Supreme Court is hearing oral arguments in a case that could significantly help the Pro-Life cause. The case regards a Mississippi law that limits abortions after 15 weeks and is called Dobbs vs. Jackson Women's Health. We are joining a nation-wide prayer effort called Adoration to Defeat Abortion. To that end, we are adding to the schedule at St. John in Union Hill this Wednesday:

- 4:00 pm Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- 4:00 5:30 pm Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament to defeat abortion
- 5:00 pm Latin Rosary (aids/pamphlets available to assist) for Our Blessed Mother's intercession to end abortion
 - 5:30 pm Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament
 - 5:35 pm Mass

All are invited to join us in prayer that God will restore in the laws of our country protection for the innocent children in the womb.


