From the Desk of Our Seminarian



I hope all have had a blessed and holy start to Advent! This is James Herzog the seminarian who has been shadowing Fr. Eugene about every month for about the past year and a half. Fr. Eugene has asked me to write a column for “Padre’s Pen”. He suggested I write about the ministry of acolyte which I was installed in on October 25.

Before I begin, I would like to first talk about what an acolyte is. The first aspect to take note of is that being an acolyte is greatly connected with the sacrament of holy orders, namely those who are deacons, priests, and bishops. So much so, that Church Law requires that a man have the ministry of acolyte for at least six months before being ordained a deacon. The Church offers this law so that the men who will be ordained will be comfortable with the functions of acolyte before they begin to pick up the functions of being a deacon and eventually a priest.

In the world, we can understand jobs and positions by understanding their function. For example, a waiter is someone who attends guests at a restaurant by taking their orders or a mayor is someone who governs a city and its people. Like many jobs in the world, we can understand the liturgical role of acolyte by understanding its function. The function of an acolyte—generally-speaking—is a person installed to assist the priest in liturgical celebrations. However, more specifically, the acolyte is to act as server of the Mass by carrying the cross, candles, or incense. In the Mass, the acolyte assists the priest by helping to prepare the altar, distributing holy communion as an extraordinary minister, and purifying the vessels of holy communion if the priest needs assistance. By understanding these functions, we can understand what an acolyte is. Through these functions, we can see such a close connection between the ministry of acolyte and priesthood. They both are serving at the altar of God and assisting the people in their worship of God. They both are greatly connected to the Eucharist in that they both can distribute it and purify the vessels that contained it.

It was a beautiful experience for me to receive this ministry of acolyte. It has been a joy for me to draw closer to the altar of God by serving and by distributing the Eucharist to all of you. As I have assisted the priest in Mass as an acolyte in the seminary and the Teaching Parish, it has been a reminder of the joy of potentially being a priest and helping people worship God.

In the ceremony, the bishop said to me while offering a vessel with bread, “Take this vessel with bread for the celebration of the Eucharist. Make your life worthy of your service at the table of the Lord and His Church.” I ask for your prayers as I continue my formation for the priesthood and that I may make my life worthy for the service of the table of the Lord.

Some things do not change over the years and rumors of the love lives of those in the public eye spread about just as much in 1910 as they do now. Bl. Karl was stationed with his regiment when he heard rumors that Zita was engaged to the Duke of Madrid. Consulting a mutual friend, he found there was nothing to it, but decided he had 'better hurry or else she really will get engaged to someone else'. Meanwhile, similar rumors were going around about Bl. Karl, as well, which prompted the Emperor to ask him to consider marriage sooner than later. Opportunity came for Bl. Karl to privately talk with Zita when they both were invited to spend the weekend at a friend's hunting lodge. That May, 1911, he proposed. Everyone was pleased with his choice.

Being this Wednesday, Dec. 8, is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, there will be no Latin Rosary or Bl. Karl Mass.

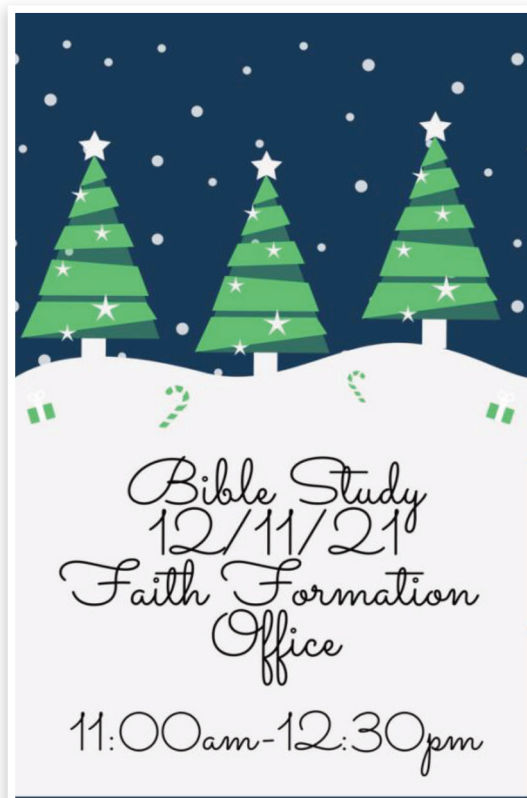
Sweepstakes Tickets went home last week!

- Did you know they are restoring some of their land to native prairie and recently planted several acres prairie grass around their property just north of New Prague?

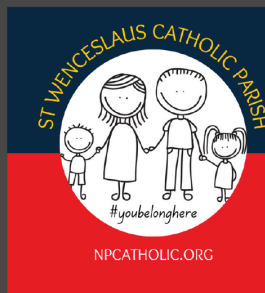

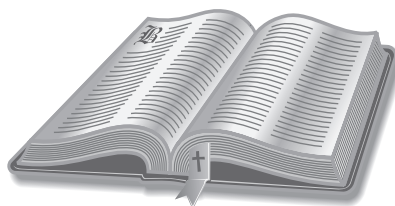
