From the Desk of Father Theisent**Padre's Pen ~
A Note from the Rectory**

Greetings from your priest in exile for COVID. It is Monday afternoon, and I am feeling overall well but tired. My main symptoms are muscle aches centered in my spine and the lingering headache that has on one occasion this morning gotten really pulsing bad. I am keeping myself well hydrated (no beer or scotch or coffee) with water, Pedialyte, and orange juice. I still have my sense of taste and smell, so my smaller meals (not quite as hungry as usual) are still quite enjoyable. I am sleeping and resting quite a bit and very hopeful that all symptoms will be gone by next week. The earliest I can return per the Minnesota Department of Health guidelines is Tuesday (10 days after initial symptoms and being symptom free on that tenth day). Thank you for all your prayers and many thanks to the parish staff who are flexing and keeping things running.

We have come to realize Covid is here to stay, for a while at least. So, we must all carefully learn to co-exist with it. Our church is a large space that holds many people, and our desire is to continue to keep as many people as safe as possible. With that being said, we are working to add an additional viewing option for our parishioners and guests who would like to still attend Mass, but at a distance. We will continue to live stream our Masses if you wish to stay home, but moving forward, you may come to the St. Wenceslaus campus and sit in the Blessed Mother Lounge to watch/attend Mass. Communion can be distributed to you in this area. Please let the ushers know you are there.

In light of the current situation and out of sensitivity for all parishioners, Archbishop Hebda strongly recommends that parishioners who attend Mass wear facemasks. We will have facemasks available in the back of church along with hand sanitizer. We kindly ask, if you are ill, please stay home.

As I said in my last Pastor's Column, the Church has always recognized that certain circumstances can excuse a person from the requirement to observe the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. Also, if you wish to receive Holy Communion on your tongue, we are temporarily restricting distribution in this manner to the presiding priest only.

As we approach the Nativity of the Lord, please pray for an end to this pandemic, for those who have lost loved ones, and for the those in the medical field, our teachers, and other frontline workers. Our Lady, Comfort of the Afflicted and Mother of the Church, pray for us. Looking forward to Christmas with you all.

Continuing Meals: Meals continue to be served at the new St. Paul Opportunity Center (SPOC) formally known as the Dorothy Day Center in St. Paul. Amid COVID, Catholic Charities has provided and requires extra measures keeping volunteers and guests safe from acquiring the virus during meal prep and serving. Please consider becoming a volunteer to prepare and serve a meal on the second Saturday of any month if you feel comfortable. No special cooking skills required. The Church of St. Wenceslaus has participated in this outreach ministry for many years. Many times, we think that God is using us to touch the lives of those who we serve. Possibly, as a volunteer, He is using those who we serve to teach us. The SPOC opened in October 2019. This new building provides additional short-term housing, computer access, a free medical clinic, and social service guidance, in addition to a dining area with a kitchen to support meal preparation. Feast of Saint John the Evangelist and the Blessing of Wine. Let's fill the pews at St. John's for the special 5:30 pm Mass being offered on Monday, December 27, in celebration of the Feast Day of our church-site patron, St. John the Evangelist. On this Patronal Feast Day, all who attend Mass at a church named after the saint can gain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions, along with the recitation of the Our Father

and Apostle's Creed on that day. A plenary indulgence is a favor granted by the Church through the merits of Jesus Who removes completely the temporal punishment remaining for sins that have been forgiven in Confession. At this Mass, Fr. Theisen will also be doing the traditional blessing of wine for the Feast of St. John. If you would like to have your wine blessed for this feast, bring the bottle(s) to Mass and Father will bless them. According to legend, wine is blessed on this day, as St. John was served poisoned wine, but survived because he blessed the wine before he put it to his lips. Thus, the wine is turned into a sacramental called the 'Love of St. John'. This sacramental wine is used throughout the year for special occasions, as well as for giving the sick. At least some of the wine blessed on the feast day should be enjoyed on the day of the feast itself. When it is drunk on his feast day, we drink it as a toast to St. John before dinner. The eldest of the house lifts his glass toward the next eldest and says, "I drink you the Love of St. John," who, in reply, says, "I thank you for the Love of St. John." This is repeated, continuing down the line in descending age order until each person has been toasted.

Christmas is a magical and amazing time for SWS. Let's enjoy it!

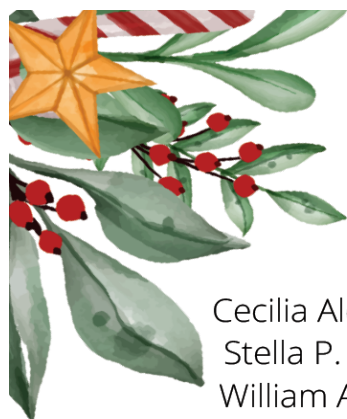
Sweepstakes Tickets!

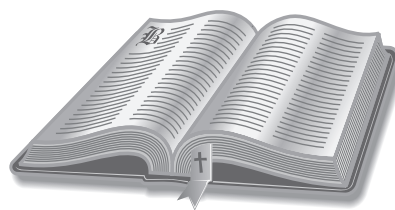
