

Prepare the Word Sunday Scripture Reflection

Holy families aren't necessarily picture-perfect. But they are faithful and consistent in their values and goals. Like Mary and Joseph and biblical parents before them, holy families consecrate their children early and often to the care of God. They do this by baptizing them and seeing to their sacramental preparation. They do this by praying for and with their little ones. They provide them a religious education and share faith-filled practices of compassion and charity. All the children in our lives look to us for love and acceptance, guidance, and Christian example. Teach the children well.

Feast of Saint John the Evangelist and the Blessing of Wine. Let's fill the pews at St. John's for the special 5:30 pm Mass being offered on Monday, December 27, in celebration of the Feast Day of our church-site patron, St. John the Evangelist. On this Patronal Feast Day, all who attend Mass at a church named after the saint can gain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions, along with the recitation of the Our Father and Apostle's Creed on that day. A plenary indulgence is a favor granted by the Church through the merits of Jesus Who removes completely the temporal punishment remaining for sins that have been forgiven in Confession. At this Mass, Fr. Theisen will also be doing the traditional blessing of wine for the

toasted.

Feast of St. John. According to legend, wine is blessed on this day, as St. John was served poisoned wine, but survived because he blessed the wine before he put it to his lips. Thus, the wine is turned into a sacramental called the 'Love of St. John'. Bring your wine bottle(s) to Mass and Father will bless them. This sacramental wine is used throughout the year for special occasions, as well as for giving the sick. At least some of the wine blessed on the feast day should be enjoyed on the day of the feast itself. When it is drunk on his feast day, we drink it as a toast to St. John before dinner. The eldest of the house lifts his glass toward the next eldest and says, "I drink you the Love of St. John," who, in reply, says, "I thank you for the Love of St. John." This is repeated, continuing down the




