

<u>Padre's</u> Pen ~ Happy Easter Resurrection of Our Lord!

God loves you so much that He became one with us in Jesus Christ. God incarnate

walked this world in peace. He preached. He healed. He taught. He forgave sins. He raised the dead to life. He experienced all that we do in a normal day to day life, except sin. Then, He took upon Himself the full weight of sin through His Passion and death. Adam and Eve's sin, King David's sin, the sins of the people who called for His Crucifixion, the sins of the Roman emperors, the sins of every atheist and agnostic, the sins of you and me all were drawn to a point in time on the Mount of Calvary and nailed to the Cross.

BI. Karl's Corner

Easter 1921 saw Bl. Karl in Hungary, trying to see if he could reclaim the throne he had been anointed for. As we will cover later, he had to 'sneak' into the country, as he had been banished by the Allies (although, France in private negotiations. promised to back him if he succeeded in reclaiming the throne). He arrived in Vienna late on Good Friday, and spent three hours in adoration, begging for Our Lord's help. Holy Saturday, he drove to Hungary, stopping the car to get out and kneel, as the Blessed Sacrament went by in procession, Easter Day, he met with the man who had been placed in charge of Hungary, an old friend who had promised to do all he could to get Karl back on the throne. Unfortunately, once in power, his friend was want to give it up. The throne could not be reclaimed without bloodshed, something many of his subjects were willing to give. Karl refused to reclaim the throne at that price, and so his attempt failed.

While riding back to Vienna. he asked his cab driver how things were in the empire. His driver outlined how difficult things had been since the war. Money was becoming more and more worthless, food and other necessities more and more expensive, services non-existent, etc.. Giving him the food he had packed for his trip, Karl also gave him a generous tip, telling him to, "Buy a nice Easter dinner for your family". As he left the cab, the driver stated, "Such enormous generosity! This could only be the Emperor Karl!"
