Padre's Pen - Thank You & **Sound System**

It was a busy week last week. With all the Corpus Christi Masses and the Procession/Picnic at St. John and the start of the

Totus Tuus Children and Youth Programs, we had a lot going on. First, THANK YOU to all who put together such a beautiful procession and picnic at St. John. We had well over one hundred people in procession honoring our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. The Benedictions went out to the North, East, South, and West for our whole parish. After the procession, we gathered for a great family day, picnic, and fundraiser. There were burgers and fixins, kickball, basketball, beanbag toss, and just plain good wholesome time spent outside on the grass. The picnic was also a fundraiser for the on-going work at St. John for the steeple and associated roofing elements. Thank you to Catholic United Financial for sponsoring and donating the food. Thank you to all our generous donors. We raised over \$3,300 for the matching grant program. We have a couple of generous donors matching dollar for dollar up to \$50,000 to preserve the historic church in Union Hill. We are over halfway to our goal of \$50,000 with over \$27,000 collected. Our deadline is October 21 to raise \$50,000. Anyone who would like to help can donate to the "St. John Matching Grant." Also, many thanks to our Faith Formation Office and the Totus Tuus team that was with us this last week! It is great to see our children and youth programs growing and the faith getting passed on to our young ones. Next up is Summer Stretch in the first week of July and Festival Camp later in July. See the bulletin for details or contact Britt in our Faith Formation Office. Lastly, I heard there was great difficulty hearing Fr. Grafsky Sunday, June 19, at St. Wenceslaus. This is one more in an extensive list of what I have been hearing since I first arrived. We are already acting on this. Last week, we had professional sound engineers visit our church, review our system, take measurements, and talk with our staff. They are currently putting together a proposal to upgrade our sound system and make it more user friendly. More to come as we look at the best way forward.

SOME PEOPLE ARE MORE COMFORTABLE CREATING SHAWLS AT HOME ON THEIR OWN TIME AND DELIVER THEM TO THE PARISH OFFICE. SHAWLS CAN BE USED FOR PEOPLE UNDERGOING MEDICAL PROCEDURES; AS A COMFORT AFTER A LOSS OR IN TIMES OF STRESS; DURING BEREAVEMENT; PRAYER OR MEDITATION; COMMITMENT OR MARRIAGE CEREMONIES; BIRTHS, NURSING A BABY; BRIDAL SHOWER OR WEDDING GIFT; LEADING RITUAL; DURING MARKHAGE CEREMONIES; BIRTHS, NURSING A BABY; BRIDAL SHOWER OR WEDDING GIT!; LEADING RITUAL; DURING AN ILLNESS AND RECOVERY; MINISTERING TO OTHERS; GRADUATION, BIRTHDAY, ANNIVERSARY, ORDINATION, HOLIDAY GIFTS; OR JUST SOCIALIZING...THE SHAWL MAKER BEGINS WITH PRAYERS AND BLESSINGS FOR THE RECIPIENT. Did you know? Every Saturday of the year, in a very old tradition in the Church, belongs to Mary, the Mother of God. It is a day to remember our Heavenly Mother with special devotion. When Christ rested in the tomb on Saturday, a time of deep grief and mourning, Mary's deep faith never wavered, nor her belief of her Son's resurrection, even though all others had abandoned Him. After the July 13, 1917, apparition of Our Lady of Fatima, the practice of First

Saturday Devotion each month to reparation and prayer, especially the rosary, grew in prominence. During the apparition, Our Lady asked for the "communion of reparation" on First Saturday, promising assistance at the hour of death to anyone who honors her Son with prayers, the rosary, confession, and the Holy Eucharist for five consecutive First Saturdays. St. Wenceslaus offers the opportunity to fulfill Our Lady's request of special prayers, rosary and Mass on every First Saturday beginning at 7:30 am. A holy hour of adoration, including confession time, is also offered every First Saturday evening at 7:00 pm, preceding the 8:15 pm Mass at St. John the Evangelist. Perhaps take some time this upcoming First Saturday of July in answer to Mary, the Mother of God, our Heavenly Mother's request of us all. Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

As this month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus closes, it is worthy of note to consider that Bl. Karl held a deep devotion to Our Lord's Sacred Heart. This was passed onto him from his mother and her father. He slept with an image of the Sacred Heart under his pillow. At that time, this imagery was not as prevalent as it is today. It had to be sought out. His hope for his empire was to promote the reign

of Christ the King. He sought to realize this through an increased devotion to the Sacred Heart.



At Fatima, our Lady said, "Men must amend their lives, and ask pardon for their sins. . . . They must no longer offend Our Lord, Who is already so much offended." Karl sought to offer our Lord solace, even before the messages of Fatima. That was another factor that played heavily in his deep desire to gain an end – not a victory – to the war.




